FLYINGINFORMATION hopped a bit at the start then was squeezed back early, settled inside, came out some in the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. SWEET ALLIE MARIE stalked between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed rally. SKIM MILK chased three deep, drifted five wide into the stretch and weakened. VERANDA CAFE broke out but on top, angled in and dueled outside the winner, stalked off the rail then alongside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FORTYFIVEWITHRUBY allowed to settle three deep, dropped back off the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch. COOL CHANCE chased between foes, dropped back into and on the turn and gave way.

XODO angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. MENSA HEAT pulled his way along inside then tugged his way up to force the pace outside a rival, was between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. POKER DAVE three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. REMUS saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. HIHO GERONIMO three deep early, chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and weakened. SHE MADE ME DO IT sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. QUALITY PLUS angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. GETOUTTHEWAY chased between horses then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened in the drive. HEYWATCHULOOKINGAT settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. BONKERSFORBINKERS chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. YES GEORGE hopped slightly at the start, settled outside chasing the pace, fell back some on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch. EXIT GLACIER settled off the inside then outside a rival, swerved out leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was not a factor. BOO TOO broke slowly, settled outside, angled in leaving the turn and failed to menace.
