DYNAMIC RANGE angled in and stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took a short lead in the stretch, kicked clear under urging and held. UNIVERSAL PEACE broke a bit slowly, pulled his way along to chase outside a rival then three deep or between foes on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. EMPEROR STONE stalked inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and was edged for second. JUSTINSIDETHEGATES chased inside then came off the rail into the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and finished with some interest. LEYVA MAN pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out in midstretch and rallied between horses. POP'SHANDS ARE HOT took the early lead and angled, set the pace a bit off the rail then dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened late. KUMIVA angled in and chased outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, found the rail approaching the second turn and lacked the needed response. CEDROS pulled his way along to chase three deep then moved up boldly four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. MONEAGLE a bit slow to begin, pulled a bit inside, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
