TONY TERRIFIC found his best stride six wide in the stretch six wide and was forced out even wider late which resulted in a claim of foul by the jockey. CORRUPT took the lead on the backstretch, weakened and was caught in the final furlong. CREEKMORE broke sharply, was bumped going into the turn, loomed a threat but was not good enough. GENERAL DARBY had the first lead, came over and bumped his foe going into the turn then faded inside. QUITE ACCEPTABLE raced in the second flight, was in tight and took up sharply going into the turn which resulted in a steward's inquiry and stopped. RACE RUN IN LANE 3. THERE WAS AN OBJECTION AND STEWARD'S INQUIRY FOR ACTIONS IN THE STRETCH WHICH RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF PAISANO CREEK FROM FIRST TO SECOND AND AN ADDITIONAL INQUIRY FOR THE ACTIONS OF GENERAL DARBY ON THE BACKSTRETCH WHICH ALSO RESULTED IN HIS DISQUALIFICATION FROM FIFTH TO SIXTH.
