JOE CARL raced between horses into the first turn while being reserved, found a good stalking position on the backstretch, moved up three wide at the quarter pole to enter the stretch three wide, made the lead at the furlong marker and drew clear late. TURBO ENERGY sped to a clear early lead on the first turn, continued to lead down the backstretch, was challenged at the quarter pole, resisted his challenger gamely through the drive and weakened in the late stages. UNCLE JEEP pressed the early leader from the outside down the backstretch, battled between horses into the lane and weakened in the final furlong. WALKER RD. chased the leaders inside then off the rail down the backstretch, but could make no impact when asked in the lane. FORM A POSSE was three wide into the first turn, chased the leaders while in the clear down the backstretch, found the inside in the stretch, but could not mount a rally.

CHURCH AVENUE had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front early on the turn, battled between horses on the bend and inside the runner-up under left handed urging in the stretch and inched away late. LADY ALEX three deep between foes early, stalked off the rail, bid three wide on the turn and into the stretch, battled alongside the winner in the drive, could not match that one late but was clearly second best. TORREY CLIFFS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, moved up just off the fence on the turn, came out into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and bested the others. JUSTINCREDIBLE a bit slow to begin, went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. UNKNOWN HEAT allowed to settle off the rail, angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TWELVE GAUGE four wide early, chased outside, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch. SOMBRE broke outward but on top, settled outside, dropped back off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in some and gave way.

ENGINE SIXTY NINE had good early speed a bit off the rail then dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and proved best. WAAFI allowed to settle off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the place. MR. INN ZONE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and held third. POINTED HOME between rivals early, stalked outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch, was in a bit tight off heels a sixteenth out and lacked the needed response. HIHO GERONIMO chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. CAJUN CORREDOR a bit slow to begin, chased inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and did not rally. DROUMERAGH (GB) angled in and dueled outside the winner, dropped back between horses into the stretch and had little left. DOGGIE BEAR dropped back outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail, angled in some on the turn and failed to menace.

SAANNEEN threw her head a bit at the start, chased three deep on the backstretch and outside on the turn, bid alongside the pacesetter in midstretch, put a head in front between foes past midstretch and was outfinished late for second. DINNR WITH NIKKI C stalked outside then alongside a rival on the backstretch and turn, drifted inward in midstretch, came out in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ORGANIC sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, fought back until past midstretch and weakened late. REASON TO RUN broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside without early speed, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. HYPER LASS stalked off the rail then a bit off the fence leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn and weakened in the stretch. BONITA SONADOR between horses early, settled just off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
