DYNASKI raced well back while wide for most of the way, launched a rally from outside leaving the turn, surged to the front approaching the final fence, battled heads apart with four across the track and edged clear under right hand urging in the final seventy yards. ARCADIUS raced inside in the early going, moved between horses on the backstretch, checked briefly along the inside on the turn, rallied between horses to challenge at the final fence and finished well for the place. SWAGGER STICK raced up close between horses, dropped back on the final turn and fought back from outside to gain a share. DALUCCI (IRE) was well placed along the inside, lodged a bid to threaten in midstretch and weakened late. SPY IN THE SKY failed to mount a serious rally while racing a bit wide. RED LETTER DAY pressed early along the inside, took the lead on the far turn and faltered in the stretch. DYNAMITE FLYER left the course nearing the final fence. HIP HOP led a good part of the way and left the course after leaving the eighth fence. FOGCUTTER fell over the eighth fence.

HAPPY WEEK dueled three wide between horses, gained a slim lead in midstretch and yielded to the winner in the final sixteenth. LIMEHEART raced well back after breaking slowly, rallied along the rail on the turn, angled out in midstretch and finished well to gain a share. DATTT ECHO dueled heads apart along the rail and tired in the final eighth. SPECKLEDBIRD pressed four wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. CAPITAL ADEQUACY checked along the rail at the half mile pole then failed to threaten while saving ground. RAPPORT dueled between horses and gave way at the quarter pole.
