TRICKY ME led nearly the entire way but couldn't stay with the winner late while holding well to best the others. NATIONBUILDER pressed the pacesetter from outside into midstretch and weakened late. YOU THE MAN was well placed along the inside for a good part of the way, lodged a mild bid on the final turn and steadily tired thereafter. AERO raced inside while well back for most of the journey and lacked a late response. OREBANKS raced in midpack along the inside, closed the gap to reach contention in upper stretch and flattened out. ZOZIMUS raced between horses to the top of the stretch and gave way. GREAT GUSTO was finished on the turn and left the course prior to the final fence. NORMANDY TOWER fell leaving the final fence. INDY RUN was outrun to the turn and left the course before the final fence. DIAMOND FEVER trailed most of the trip and left the course approaching the final fence.

LUCY N THUNDER was outrun early, gained in the two path in upper stretch and weakened late. GRAND DECISION stumbled at the start, chased four wide for a half and lacked a strong closing response. MYWIFENOSEVRYTHING pressed the winner early, dropped back on the turn and gave way. RED ZINN showed only brief speed along the inside.

MULTIPASS was bumped by QUISOM at the start, was unhurried between horses for five furlongs, advanced four wide while splitting horses at the quarter pole and finished willingly to gain the place. QUISOM broke inward at the start, sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the front to the top of the stretch and gradually tired thereafter. TRAINEE was outrun to the turn, circled five wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. ESPERANZA D'ORO raced in good position along the rail and gave way nearing the quarter pole.
