HE'S LONG GONE pressed between horses for six furlongs, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and held off the runner-up under steady urging. TWISTED DREAM stumbled badly at the start, was outrun for a half, angled in midway on the turn, swung three wide entering the stretch then closed steadily but could not get up. LONGING FOR MALIBU checked between horses nearing the seven-eighths pole, saved ground to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. LOFTY BANNER steadied between horses entering the backstretch, raced just off the pace for five furlongs, split horses on the turn and lacked a further response. YANKEE CHIEF was outrun along the rail after breaking slowly. EL WINDO dueled along the rail inside the winner to the turn and gave way. MR. PETERSSON tucked in along the rail for five furlongs and lacked the needed response when called upon. ONE LUCKY DATE pressed three wide for five furlongs and faltered.

MADISON steadied sharply after being bothered at the start, was outrun for a half, circled six wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. SPENCERIFIC settled in the middle of the pack, raced between horses on the turn and rallied mildly. UNCLE PAT checked slightly at the start, raced up close while three wide for a half and lacked a late response. TEN CARROT NIKKI pressed the pace under a firm hold for a half, relinquished the lead to the winner nearing the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. MAILBU GARDENS steadied sharply at the start, trailed for a half, circled six wide and lacked a late response. SMARTY KARAKORUM ducked in bothering horses at the start, raced up close along the rail to the far turn and gave way. ONE WAY BRUCE dueled briefly along the rail and faltered on the turn.

SPY IN THE SKY was unhurried a good part of the way, closed the gap leaving the ninth fence, gained rapidly to take the lead from outside entering the stretch, opened a comfortable advantage nearing the final fence and drew away under steady right hand urging. SERMON OF LOVE was rated along the inside for most of the trip, swung out on the turn, took up chase after the winner in upper stretch but was no match while clearly best of the others. DALUCCI (IRE) settled behind the loose leader for a good part of the way, opened a clear advantage leaving the ninth fence, led to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. SWAGGER STICK raced in the middle of the pack well off the inside and tired in upper stretch. MIXED UP never reached contention while trailing most of the trip. SLIP AWAY opened a long lead, gave way on the far turn and left the course approaching the last fence.
