EXECUTIVE DREAM settled off the pace, circled six-wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out and drove clear. SLEW'S KID raced midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn, challenged at the top of the stretch, battled gamely but was outfinished. NO MOLESTAR showed brief speed, chased on the turn, gained the lead nearing the top of the stretch, was headed just into the final furlong and weakened. HARD FOUR showed brief speed and settled, closed five-wide late turn, launched a bid upper stretch but failed to get up and flattened out. TWICE WILD had brief early foot, stalked the pace from between horses, ducked out late turn then evened out in the stretch. MAJESTIC MONTANA raced off the pace, closed late turn, was forced out late turn then flattened out in the stretch. PLEASE WIN AGAIN, off slowly, was hustled on the turn but tired in the stretch. NORTHERN PROMISING had speed, shook clear approaching the turn, set the pace then tired late turn and was done. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE RUN THROUGH THE TURN CONCERNING TWICE WILD AND MAJESTIC MONTANA RESULTED IN TWICE WILD BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERING WITH HIS RIVAL.

GOLDY SONG raced midpack, was hustled late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch, rallied gamely and got up late under a hand ride. BALLYCANOE forced the pace from the rail, chased on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch, gained a narrow advantage a 16th out but failed to hold the winner safe. FUNNY PECULIER, always prominent, stalked on the turn, closed into the stretch then finished gamely between horses. J R TOMMYHAWK had outside speed, led on the turn, was engaged at the top of the stretch, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. HURRY BACK raced midpack, closed late backstretch, was hustled between foes on the turn then finished determinedly. CITOYEN settled off the pace, angled out on the turn, was five-wide at the top of the stretch then rallied belatedly. PLAYBOY AT HOME raced off the pace, angled from the third to the fifth path on the turn, rallied mildly but needed more. MOLINARO TEMPO led midway of the backstretch, set a reserved pace, quickened late turn then held sway under a drive. IM TALKIN BOUT ME, in touch three-deep, lugged in on the turn and through the stretch but rallied willingly despite himself. EVIL COMMANDER stalked the pace, closed on the turn, chased into the stretch, finished all out but hung. I'LL BUY stalked from the rail, chased late turn, was determined in the stretch but evened out late. RING MY SURPRISE, in touch between rivals, was roused late turn but finished evenly. ICY JET, in striking range outside rivals, chased into the stretch but lacked a strong closing response. FOUND THE TREASURE settled off the pace, angled out chasing late turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. CAT AND CUSTARD, in touch two-deep, was hustled late turn then flattened out in the final furlong. BOO BOO'S LOVE was in range between horses, chased late turn then flattened out along the rail.
