SOFTLY SINGING stalked the dueling leaders in a good position down the backstretch, moved up three wide to challenge at the quarter pole and drew out under strong handling through the lane while in hand in the final yards. NEEKO dueled for the early lead from the outside, entered the lane between horses and finished well without being a threat to the winner. HARISSA broke outward slightly at the start, chased the early leaders on the outside, rallied to gain some ground in the final furlong. MULTIFACETED saved ground while chasing the leaders on the backstretch and turn, finished evenly when asked in the final furlong. LINDA SURPRISE sped to the early lead, dueled on the inside into the lane and weakened in the stretch drive. MADE TO ORDER was off slowly, chased from the rear of the pack down the backstretch and had no rally when asked in the lane.

FURIOSO STAR was in a good position stalking the pace while saving ground, continued inside in the stretch and edged a rival for the place. DOC ON THE ROCK had speed a bit off the rail then stalked the winner, bid alongside that one on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and was edged for second. DELUXE CAT a half step slow into stride, settled inside, came out nearing midstretch and was not a threat. FEAR NO EVIL stalked outside a rival or off the rail on the backstretch, continued between foes into the turn and alongside a rival into the stretch and did not rally. CORONEL MOLDES chased outside then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn, continued a bit wide into the stretch and weakened.

BOX OFFICE QUEEN pulled her way along a bit off the rail then came out into the first turn, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, drifted out under left handed pressure in midstretch and pulled clear in deep stretch. PRINCESS WINDSHARP sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, kicked clear on the backstretch, dueled along the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. FIRST QUEEN (GB) four wide in the chute, went five wide into the first turn, chased three deep then off the rail on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and got up for the show four wide on the line. PLAYA BONITA pulled between horses and steadied early, went four wide into the first turn, chased between horses or outside a rival, went between foes again in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. BLACK MAGIC MAMA hopped slightly in a bit of an awkward start, was bumped between foes in tight leaving the chute, chased inside to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. INCA'S FLIGHT pulled her way along to stalk the pace off the rail, bid between foes leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SMARTYSIDEUP bumped slightly leaving the chute, saved ground off the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and failed to menace.

CIGAR MAN chased outside, went up three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage while lugging in a bit past midstretch and drew clear under a crack of the whip, steady handling and a long hold late. SPURRIER settled outside a rival then chased inside, came out into the stretch and got up for the place three deep on the wire. YANKEE STATION broke in a bit, stalked just off the rail, moved up inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch and split rivals late for the show. CAPTURE THE CALL sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, held on well until past midstretch, could not match the winner and gave ground grudgingly late to the others. TANGLED TANGO close up stalking the pace inside to the stretch, weakened. REFLECT TIMES (JPN) saved ground, dropped back on the backstretch, came out a bit in the stretch and did not rally. LOCKFORD allowed to settle off the rail, went outside foes on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. EL TROFEO (ARG) stalked outside a rival, was between horses leaving the second turn, dropped back, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.

STAR REDEEMER turned his head and broke slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. STEADY DEMAND dueled outside the runner-up then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid between horses leaving the turn and through the stretch and was narrowly outfinished for a minor award. RUSSIAN LIQUOR broke in a bit, stalked outside then between foes, continued three deep on the turn, bid three wide leaving the turn and in the stretch and was outkicked late. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER squeezed a bit at the start, was in a good position stalking the pace outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary response. THE BAT SIGNAL chased outside then alongside a rival, was between horses into and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PLENTY JADE close up stalking the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, waited a bit leaving the turn, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MENSA HEAT angled in and chased inside on the backstretch and turn, split horses into the stretch and again in midstretch and lacked the necessary late kick. SIDEPOCKET LOU allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DR. J J broke a bit in the air, chased just off the rail then angled to the inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
