SCAMP AND A HALF moved up soon after the start to take control when asked, got clear in the turn, expanded that advantage upper stretch, not threatened thereafter. SMELL THE ROSES broke out, straightened to settle off the pace toward the inside, shuffled back in the turn, switched out when straightened for home, finished willingly to earn the place while not a threat to the winner. COURTESAN'S SONG broke out, raced back off the pace, three wide into the turn, four wide out, closest to the winner a furlong out, no match for the runner up late, finished up best of the rest. RAINBOW KISSES broke sharp, vied up front off the inside early, fell back in the turn, continued to fade stretch. MERCY CAME ARUNNIN void of early foot, came five wide into the stretch, displayed some mild late interest well out in the strip. SASS IN THE CITY off the pace, in some traffic in the far turn, lacked a response in the drive. TWINKLE TERRI in tight at the start, raced back and never threatened in a dull effort. TORINADO forwardly placed on the outside for a half, retreated through the stretch. SMOLDERIN MEMORIES four wide through the turn, gave way.

MINDY SUE forwardly placed, lodged a mild bid outside the winner turning for home, proved no match for that one in the drive, remained clear for the place. BAR BABE lacked speed, four wide in the second flight exiting the final turn, no match for the top two in the drive. SHE'S A WOW showed the way early, weakened after five furlongs. LIKE CANDY slight bobble at the start, raced forwardly early, had little left for the drive. ENJOY THE SCORE trailed well back, came five wide out of the second turn, managed little in the way of a rally. FAR EAST tired after a half.

WANNABEAROCKSTAR forwardly placed, fell back in traffic late in the turn, continued behind horses into the lane, moved out, coming late. CAJUN SECRET away in good order, narrowly set the pace three wide, narrowly showed the way into and through upper stretch, gave way when headed the final furlong. TACONITE vied early along the inside, faded out of a front running position into the turn, continued inside entering the stretch, moved out a bit for the drive, evenly late. RULER'S VISION last away, moved up, pressured the pace off the inside, weakened in the drive. LIL SILVER DOLLAR lacked a late bid. BEN'S YO trailed throughout.
