GUERRERO NEGRO moved up inside to make a clear early lead, maintained the advantage to the lane and drew out in the final furlong. BETTINGONTHEFLY was bumped at the start, chased inside down the backstretch, angled off the rail on the turn to enter the stretch three wide and rallied to be a clear second at the wire. FERRELIA stalked the pacesetter from the outside down the backstretch, remained in contention at the top of the lane, and gradually weakened in the final furlong. CHEROKEE SUN stalked the pacesetter from the inside to the top of the lane, remained on the inside through the drive and could not mount a sufficient rally. EDENISE was bumped and steadied at the start to be away slowly, was outrun down the backstretch and failed to mount a rally through the stretch drive. BATTLE POINT chased outside a rival into the turn and then fell back and was not a threat thereafter.

A ROYAL TIZZY dueled then set pressured pace from the inside, drifted out some exiting the turn, continued on three wide path in the lane and safely held. SIDPOCKET LOU tucked in behind dueling leaders, remained along the rail, brushed with outside foe in upper stretch, loomed in mid stretch and went willingly to the wire. SAXOPHONE stalked pace from between horses, remained on same path into and around the turn, brushed with runner-up in upper stretch and bested others. LARDOG reserved from the inside then chased on two wide path around the bend, remained bit off the rail and was outfinished for show. LITTLE BRO tracked the leaders from the outside and three abreast, remained on same path around the turn, came four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. TONY MONTANA was off bit slow and awkwardly, angled out on the turn, remained wide, gave way readily in the stretch, fell and unseated rider shortly after the finish but was walked off. PROUD HERITAGE dueled then forced the issue from outside winner, lost contact on the turn, came three wide into the lane and weakened.

LADY ALEX led second flight while slightly off the rail, steadily whittled gap on leader around second turn, powered past pacesetter nearing mid stretch and cleared under steady hand pressure. WOMAN WARRIOR quickly sped to the front and kicked well clear into backstretch, padded big cushion to second bend, had that margin evaporate and had little resistance for winner in the lane. WIN ALLISON WIN chased while bit off the fence, remained on same path into the stretch and gamely held the show. REAL FANCY RUNNER caught three wide early, raced outside rival, roused on final turn, came four wide into the lane and was outfinished for third. VIKKILEE settled four wide into first turn, lagged back while bit wide, remained three wide exiting last bend, came out further but was no threat. TURNING TOP (IRE) broke in some, reserved from between horses, lagged back along the rail, saved ground but gave way steadily in the stretch.

AFLEET MAGIC angled over and settled off the pace, made steady progress three then four wide into the stretch, reached the front and kicked clear while coming in some. BIG JAY angled over the tracked leading pair into backstretch, moved alongside leader on second turn, gained lead, edged away, was overtaken in upper stretch and gamely held second. CANDY COAT settled outside, chased four wide, advanced and forced six wide into the stretch, surged to the front and kicked clear. PRINCE NOVETTI stalked from the inside, angled out, moved up three then four wide into the lane, rallied between and gained second. RAJA was off slow and slow into stride, angled out around the turn, was four wide exiting the turn and finished strongly from off the rail. JUSTICE REIGNS close up early from between foes, came four wide around the turn, loomed in upper stretch but was outfinished. KISSID lagged back while angling over, chased along rail into the lane, came off the fence and improved placing. WHIZER chased from off the rail, remained three wide to the turn, shifted out, forced seven wide entering the stretch and finished with interest. PREVAILING WIND (GB) reserved off the leaders, came in some, between foes then two wide to the stretch and never menaced.

ONEINAMILLIONYOU advanced from the inside, joined leader briefly into the turn, dropped back around the bend and weakened. QUICK J FINLAY prompted the pace, remained prominent while three then four wide into the lane but also weakened. DELAGO settled from between horses, gradually angled over leaving backstretch, found the fence, moved up inside, lacked room and steadied through the lane and never recovered. QUIET FOREST sped to the front, set pace while bit off the rail, was overtaken in upper stretch, came in bit and gave way. A PINT FOR MARY settled off the rail, came in some, was two wide entering the stretch and lacked any response.
