BROOKIE GIRL stalked the pacesetter to the turn, moved up to prompt the pace to the top of the lane, took command and drew out in the final furlong. FLASHY TRAVELER was outrun between foes into the turn, improved her position on the turn, swung out for the drive to rally and gain the place in the late stages. PAULASAHORSEONYA was off a bit slowly and outrun to the turn, went into the turn three wide, moved up on the turn, rallied through the lane and was outfinished for the place in the final yards. TRIPPED FUSE sped to the early lead on the inside, maintained the advantage to the top of the lane when headed and gradually weakened on the inside in the final furlong. WARREN'S JOSEPHINE stalked the pace on the outside into the turn, remained in a contending position to the lane and gradually weakened in the drive. WILLOW MISS chased inside into the turn, began to fall back on the turn and was no threat in the stretch drive. TOUCH LUCK chased inside into the turn, came out for the drive and failed to mount a stretch rally.

ONE SHOT (ARG) had speed outside a rival then bumped with that one into the first turn, took the lead, angled in and kicked clear, opened up between calls on the backstretch, responded when challenged on the second turn to inch away again and proved best under urging. CAMISADO (FR) chased outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and just got the place. GENERAL DAN was in a good position chasing the winner a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and was edged late for second. CANDY ARCHES pulled his way along inside, bumped with the winner and steadied into the first turn, stalked off the rail, bid alongside that one on the second turn, fell back into the stretch and weakened. ABSOLUTE GLORY allowed to settle off the pace inside, continued along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and failed to menace. FILM FORTUNE chased between horses then outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. MINISTER BLAIR settled a bit off the rail chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary response. FUJI (IRE) unhurried three deep into the first turn, dropped back off the rail and was through early. Claims of foul by the rider and assistant trainer of CANDY ARCHES against the winner for alleged interference into the first turn were not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the former contributed to his own trouble.

SPANISH BUNNY pulled between horses then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the winner leaving the second turn, was no match for that one in the stretch but held second. TORREY CLIFFS broke slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gained the show late. FOXY APPROVAL broke in a bit and bobbled slightly at the start, was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished late for third. WARRENS SWEETHEART had speed inside then stalked along the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. WARREN'S ROYAL MOM saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, lugged inward in the drive and could not summon the necessary response. HARBOR READY settled off the pace inside, came out some into the stretch and in midstretch and was not a threat. MISSTRAILCITYZONE chased outside or off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
