KAZROAD (NZ) was outrun down the hill, hopped when crossing the main track, rallied outside through the lane and was going well at the finish. HIT THE BRIX chased on the inside down the hill, remained inside for the drive and could not threaten in the final furlong. WARREN'S BECKA chased outside a rival down the hill, was between horses through the lane and lacked a sufficient rally. Rail on hill at 7 feet.

AUTOCUE (GB) between horses early, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid between foes under left handed urging past midstretch to gain the lead, bumped with the runner-up in late stretch and gamely prevailed. HEROI DO BAFRA (BRZ) settled three deep then off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well while bumping with the winner late. CADEAUX DU MONDE (GB) pulled his way to the early lead and angled in, set the pace off the rail, widened his advantage on the backstretch, continued just off the inside in the stretch, was overtaken past midstretch but held third. GRAFTON three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOUVENIR SLEW hopped some at the start, settled inside, split horses into the stretch, angled back in and could not offer the necessary late response. WINK AND NOD saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back into the stretch, came out in midstretch and weakened.

MULTIPLYINGTHEHEAT saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch, steadied when crowded in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. DONIA chased inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and did not rally. GOLDEN GREEK chased outside a rival or off the rail, drifted inward in the stretch and was not a threat. BRUIN BALLETT chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and weakened. I SMELL VICTORY pulled her way to the early lead, set the pace just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, dropped back between horses, drifted in, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.

STRIKINGLY SINFUL saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in late stretch and was in a bit tight between foes nearing the wire.
