SINGLE MALT unhurried after being steadied on the first turn, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to take over inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. ARCH THIRTEEN allowed to settle, was caught in tight on the far turn, angled out for the drive and closed to be up for the place. UNBRIDLED FUTURE chased the pace into the stretch and was outfinished by the top ones while continuing on with good courage for the show. SUPER STRESSED outrun early, rallied along the rail to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole, then flattened out. TESTED set the pace along the inside to past the eighth pole, then weakened. SURFER RANDY rated off the pace, raced in contention three wide around the far turn but didn't do enough late. JUNGLE CHIEF failed to menace. ALL WEST chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader leaving the far turn and into the stretch, then gave way. SOULFULLY tracked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. TRADER JOHN tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered.

GIRL rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, was caught in behind the weaving winner inside the eighth pole, then was gaining slowly on that rival at the finish. RUBY ROUGE unhurried early, rallied along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late. ROCKET ZEE rated off the pace, made a run to reach the leaders in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. TRADITIONALISM chased the pace three wide, then was caught in tight at the top of the stretch, then weakened. LA MANA showed speed along the inside to the eighth pole, then tired. KATHY'S RIBBONS failed to menace. GIMMEAHUG was never a factor. YOGI'S VALENTINE chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the turn and into the stretch, then faltered. The rider of U. K. GIRL lodged an objection against the rider of SMART CITY DOC for alleged interference in the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.

MARIA'S DAUGHTERS reserved after stumbling at the start, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. PUT THAT AWAY off slowly, was allowed to settle, then passed tired rivals in the drive. CODE LEGAL unhurried early, improved her position without threatening. BUDDHAFUL LADY chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach even terms for command midway of the turn, then tired. DREWLEE well placed, steadied in traffic on the backstretch, then was saving ground when steadied again on the turn and gave way. POUPON showed early foot, raced four wide on the turn and faltered. LET'S GO OUT WEST was outrun. T T GOURMET showed little. SHE WALKS ON AIR showed speed off the rail into the turn and faded. LOVELY VANESSA clipped heels with MARIA'S DAUGHTER on the backstretch and dropped back. There was a stewards inquiry and the rider of LOVELY VANESSA lodged an objection against the rider of MARIA'S DAUGHTERS for alleged interference on the backstretch.
