MISS SNOW NOSE off bit closer, closer inside late backstretch, set down for the drive, no match for the top two. SAPRISTI pulled hard in the early going in some traffic, raced within striking distance, three wide into the lane, lacked a late kick. INFLECTION forwardly placed while three wide and outside the winner, came up empty for the drive. A P DILLY moved closer while four wide turning for home, hung in the drive. RACHEL DAWN fell far back, distanced.
