SEND HIM IN forced the early pace from the inside, dueled on the turn and gained a short lead at the top of the stretch, was quickly passed by the winner and tired. MECKE B KING was always well back, responded only mildly to rousing late turn and did not menace.

REGAL PUSHER was in midpack early, dropped back a bit and chased from off the pace on the turn and was not a threat. WALZIN TO T MUSIC raced midpack on the inside, saved ground while being hustled on the turn then evened out in the stretch. UPMARKET GIRL, up close early, was being hustled but dropped back steadily on the turn then lacked a closing response. ASTERA dropped back early, was hustled on the turn but lacked a rally.
