SKIFF'S ARGUMENT angled inwards after the break gaining terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's pace to upper stretch, edged forward to a clear advantage leaving the furlong marker and held the challenge of BACKSTABBER under firm handling. The latter, held up just off the leaders along the inside racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch, altered course avoiding close quarters leaving the furlong marker to split foes late and steadily closed the gap on the winner. MAWAAQEF broke slowly while brushing ONE GOAL, was switched out three deep entering the turn while momentarily shifting into the path of SYNCHRONICITY TOO, bid in that path entering upper stretch but was outfinished. ONE GOAL was hustled to the lead, set the pace along the rail to midstretch but failed to sustain his momentum. SYNCHRONICITY TOO tracked just off and outside foes in the opening stages, was forced out entering the bend and quickly gave way. SIR WOODINGTON, going a bit erratically from the outset, was never a factor.

COACH ABS attended the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, edged forward to a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, drifted inwards in late stages but prevailed under brisk handling. PROUD EXPRESSION broke readily, attended a rival's pace along the inside while under some reserve, disputed the issue nearest the rail into upper stretch, raced in tight quarters in the final sixteenth and was outfinished. MY MAN JAY stalked just off and outside the first flight racing to the bend, advanced to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while not quite matching terms with the top pair. LEADING INDICATOR tracked the leaders along the inside, shifted out with a sharp move to race four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. YONA TORY, off a step slowly, never gained striking distance. BUDDY'S BID dropped out of contention early.

NIC THE QUICK tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight to the backstretch, continued unhurried into the far turn, shifted out five wide approaching upper stretch to challenge, took charge leaving the furlong marker and went clear under firm encouragement. BRUNZER moved to a forward placing along the rail from the outset, tracked the pacesetter under rating to the far turn, angled out four wide to bid between foes in upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but secured the place. MINISTER'S JOY tracked just off and outside the second flight in the opening half, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and just missed the place. D' WILDCARD was held up off the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, made a sharp move to contention racing three deep on the backstretch, challenged in that path nearing upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. MAJESTIC ZEAL was urged clear while angling over racing into the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin into the far turn, resisted several challenges racing into upper stretch but weakened late. DAVID K tracked the leaders unhurried saving ground to the backstretch, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch to split foes four wide late while gaining striking distance but made no real impression on the leaders. SPIDER POWER (IRE), reserved saving ground in the opening stages, continued along the inside to upper stretch but never gained striking distance. STEPASIDE tracked the pace outside a rival in second flight, moved to challenge the pacesetter in tandem with a rival between foes entering the far turn and flattened out nearing midstretch.

VALISE secured a forward placing along the rail in the opening stages while relinquishing the lead to a rival, tracked that foe under some reserve in the opening half, shifted out to advance on that foe nearing the second bend, pressed the leader for command racing through the far turn and went clear in upper stretch, widening his advantage under firm encouragement. BATTEN was urged to the lead racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the second bend, couldn't match terms when challenged by the winner but proved best of the others. UNBRIDLED VICAR, reserved saving ground to the backstretch, switched out four wide entering the far turn to advance, continued in that path to upper stretch and edged a rival for third while making steady progress to the end. HOT ROLSTON tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to the backstretch, shifted three wide to challenge between foes racing through the far turn, continued inside a rival to late stages and was just outfinished for a share. MINING FOR SILVER tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside in second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. MOLANDER was held up just off pace outside a rival in the opening half but emptied out when called upon racing through the far turn.

The latter tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight under reserve to the backstretch, pulled his way to striking distance three deep leaving the far turn, steadily closed the gap on the winner but proved only second best. I COME FROM BEHIND tracked the leaders just behind the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, angled four wide racing through upper stretch and made a steady effort to improve his position. ICE CLIMBER, reserved outside a rival in the opening half, angled out five wide racing through upper stretch and made some belated progress. READY TO PLAY tracked just off the leaders along the inside to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SWITCHING TO GLIDE, held up three wide racing just off the second flight to the backstretch, lacked the necessary closing response. WEKIVA WACHEE angled inwards gaining a forward placing racing to the first turn, attended a rival's pace for six furlongs and emptied out in upper stretch. STAND AND APPLAUD, cast in the gate before the start, never seriously menaced.

STEALTH WOMAN, forwardly placed along the rail from the outset, attended a rival's pace under light rating, shook clear when called upon nearing midstretch and steadily widened her advantage under firm encouragement. SATIN SWEEP, held up just off the leaders along the inside racing to the turn, angled three wide in upper stretch while drifting into the path of MISS FONTANA and narrowly edged that foe in late stages to secure the place. MISS FONTANA tracked just off the leaders between foes racing into the bend, was fanned four wide in upper stretch while continuing with a steady effort and was just outfinished for the place. KEL'S DREAMER broke inwards, was urged to prompt the pace pace outside a rival racing to the bend, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. HAPPY HENRIETTA ducked inwards bumping STIVERS SURPRISE at the start, was collected off that foe to track the pace unhurried off the inside, shifted five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. STIVERS SUPRISE, bumped at the start, was settled along the inside in the opening stages, switched outside foes nearing upper stretch to race six wide in the lane but made no impression. EUROPA ROYALE shifted outside foes to track off the first flight four deep early, continued with a brief, three wide bid on the bend but gave way early.
