RIVRAV broke sharply, sprinted clear of his foes while angling over, opened a commanding margin on the turn and held sway to the end under firm handling. PERJURY angled inwards chasing the pacesetter outside his entrymate, proved no match for the winner but was best of the others. IMPERSONATOR bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to gain a tracking position in the second flight along the inside and finished evenly while earning a share. CITIZEN WEST, caught five wide early, came around foes on the bend to improve his position. SMACK RIDGE tracked the pace between foes racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. CATCH THE TRAIN tracked the leaders in hand along the inside just off the second flight, then steadily faded nearing the lane. FRANKLIN COUNTY hopped at the start, was shuffled a bit out of close quarters entering the turn and never seriously menaced. SMARTY SPRINGS broke slowly and trailed throughout.

LITTLEBITEVEN broke inwards brushing OUTLAW ZEN, was reserved just off the leaders tracking the pace along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out leaving the furlong marker and continued well enough to secure the place. OUTLAW BOUNTY prompted the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way once headed by the winner. OUTLAW ZEN was urged to the fore along the inside, dueled into upper stretch and emptied out. PHIL THE THRILL tracked the pace unhurried outside foes racing to the turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch.

LIL CARMELITA broke readily, was held up just outside the first flight in the opening half, continued under some reserve three deep between foes on the turn, split foes in that path nearing upper stretch to challenge and prevailed in the final stages under firm handling. VAULTS LAST SISTER moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dueled for command into the lane, couldn't contain the winner's final bid but held well enough to earn the place. OH MY SWEETIE PIE, reserved off the leaders while switching nearer the inside in the opening stages, angled out while moving readily to striking distance on the turn racing four deep, switched out five wide in upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to the end to close the gap on the top pair and earn a share. SHESA TOUGH KITTY, prominent between foes from the outset, attended a rival's pace in the opening half, pressed the issue through the turn and weakened in late stages. I'VE HEARD RUMORS, off a bit slowly, was guided to the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and steadily improved her position. OVID FASTI, forwardly placed outside foes from the break, pressed the pace racing three wide into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. ARCHIPELAGO angled to the inside in the opening stages while securing a tracking position just behind the first flight, continued in that path for six furlong and steadily faded entering upper stretch. MAYBE BABY stumbled at the start, was settled outside foes in the opening half, advanced to striking position racing four wide on the turn but flattened out nearing upper stretch. THELMA'S SONGCAT tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside in the opening stages but soon dropped out.
