FLY'N LION, reserved in hand saving ground to the backstretch, shifted off the inside after a half drafting behind the first flight to the far turn, shifted out to bid four wide leaving the furlong marker, drifted inwards a bit under pressure in late stages but prevailed under firm handling. TWO NINETY FIVE tracked the pace unhurried outside a rival to the backstretch, made steady progress to gain terms with a foe in second flight after a half, advanced three wide on the far turn to press the issue into upper stretch and continued with interest between foes to prevail for the place while failing to contain the winner. BUD SYMONDS, reserved on the rail in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out leaving the furlong marker to bid between foes four wide, then steadied a bit in close quarters in the final stages while just outfinished for the place. DOUBLEFOUR angled inwards to track just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, advanced to press the issue between foes racing through the far turn, then drifted a bit into the path of GUIDING MISSILE while weakening in late stages while feeling the effects of a strong crosswind. MORE THAN ABLE, off a step slow, then bumped at the break, settled off the inside early, advanced three deep on the second bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. GUIDING MISSILE dictated the pace on a clear margin along the inside to the far turn, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in late stages while racing in close quarters along the inside. STAND AND APPLAUD broke inwards bumping, was guided to the inside early, made a brief advance on the far turn but flattened out in the drive. STEPS SILVER HALO, caught a bit wide early, soon dropped out of contention. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF BUD SYMONDS LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDERS OF FLY'N LION AND TWO NINETY FIVE, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.

MESONIC secured a forward placing racing to the first turn, angled inwards midway through that bend to gain a tracking position along the rail, lost some position to the leaders on the backstretch while continuing unhurried, steadily closed the gap on the leaders racing through the far turn, took charge near midstretch and pulled clear under firm handling. AWESOME ATTACK, off a step slow, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to secure the place. CALL TO GLORY prompted the pace outside a rival into the backstretch, moved well clear of the field on the backstretch, pressed that foe into upper stretch and gave out once confronted by the winner. NEXT KITTEN angled to the rail in early stages tracking the pace under some reserve, saved ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress late. CIRCUIT BOARD was settled near the inside in the opening half and passed some tiring rivals in the lane. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD, pulling his way along the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command into the far turn and emptied out. RUN BIG BUD RUN drifted well wide racing through the first turn and never gained striking distance. DALAXY tracked the pace unhurried to the backstretch but offered no rally. TANK'S LETTER was held up between foes tracking just off the second flight in the opening half but steadily retreated from contention. YEARS AGO, a bit rank under restraint in the opening stages, soon dropped out of contention.
