PATSY'S LIL BUDDY settled while chasing the pace down the backstretch, came between horses entering the stretch, rallied on the outside in the final furlong and was up in time. GIRL OF PANGAEA (GER) pressed the pacesetter throughout, put a head in front at the furlong marker, battled to the wire and was outfinished late. POWEROFVOODOO chased on the inside around both turns, angled to the rail for the final furlong and finished willingly. PARTY WITH BRANDO broke through the gate prior to the start, broke alertly, chased between around the first turn, was outside a rival on the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. LULLABYTIME chased outside a foe down the backstretch, was four wide entering the stretch, outfinished in the final furlong, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. HIDDEN ROMANCE pulled her way to the early lead, maintained the advantage to the stretch and gradually weakened in the final furlong. WARRENS HIGHROLLER chased inside a rival down the backstretch, remained inside for the drive and could not mount a rally.

DAYLIGHT STORM angled in and dueled outside the winner throughout and continued willingly to the wire. IVORY FUDGE broke a bit slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the show. PRECIOUS DUKE close up stalking the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and was outfinished for third. FORTHREEFOREUCLID chased outside then alongside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAJESTIC PEAK settled between horses then chased just off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. FANDINO a bit slow to begin, pulled a bit early, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, was between foes past midstretch and weakened.

NINTH INFANTRY angled in and chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. SANDY CHEEKS also angled in then came off the rail on the first turn to stalk the pace, bid three deep on the second turn, put a head in front, inched clear in the stretch and was caught late. L'ENCHANTERESSE (IRE) pulled her way into a bit of a tight spot early, chased inside, came out for room into the stretch and picked up the show. JAWS N' PAWS saved ground off the pace, cut the corner into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and bested the others. GLENDIVE allowed to settle outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn, steadied off heels nearing the stretch, came three deep into the lane and could not offer the necessary late kick. MAGIC LANTERN (GB) came out early, went three deep on the first turn then chased outside, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SKY CHANT pulled her way alongside a rival early then stalked just off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened.
