CATHY'S CRUNCHES pressed outside the pacesetter to midstretch, took over the lead approaching the sixteenth marker and inched away in the final yards. ALASKA MISS moved up to take the early lead on the inside, maintained the advantage past the furlong marker, battled to the wire on the inside and was clearly second best. GATOR AT FONZ'S stalked the pace outside a rival into the turn, came into the stretch three wide and held the show spot in the run to the wire. MICHAILASHEARTLITE stalked between horses into the turn, angled to the inside for the drive and lacked the needed response. MISS NIKKI C. was taken in hand after the start, steadied between horses while rank on the backstretch, steadied again on the inside on the turn while continuing to pull and was unable to make any impact in the stretch drive.

PRINCE OF GOTHAM chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, was briefly between horses on the second turn, found the inside into the stretch, bid along the fence under urging in midstretch, gained a narrow advantage in deep stretch, drifted out some late and gamely prevailed. MINISTER D'ORO settled just off the inside chasing the pace, came out in upper stretch, split horses past midstretch and again at the wire for the place. THE UNUSUAL ONE pulled a bit and dueled three deep then outside a rival, fought back between horses through the final furlong and continued willingly to save the show. CANTONA settled a bit off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied five wide on the wire. WARREN'S ROUGH LUV pulled his way between horses then dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and between rivals through the final furlong and also continued willingly to the end. PAPA LEV pulled along the inside forcing the early pace then stalked off the rail, bid three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, dropped back past midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.

EQUIPARADO (ARG) chased inside, steadied and went around CONATO early on the turn, regained the rail into the stretch, continued inside and did not rally. PATRIOTIC SOLDIER was in a good position stalking the pace off the rail on the backstretch and turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and weakened. CONATO came out early, angled in and chased between horses then inside, was pulled up in distress on the turn and vanned off.

CALIFORNIA SOLDIER stalked outside a rival of off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the lead a quarter mile out and pulled clear under urging and strong handling. BROTHER LOUIE chased inside then off the rail on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some and picked up the place. MINISTERS POWER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside or off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, dueled briefly inside the winner leaving the second turn and weakened some but held third. MILTY WAY wide early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, angled in nearing the stretch and did not rally. LUV DRAGON three deep early, chased outside a rival or off the inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. COOKIE RULES a bit fractious in the gate, angled in early then came off the rail into the backstretch, angled in again for the second turn, was in a bit close off heels in deep stretch and was not a threat. LITECORR pulled between horses and steadied approaching the first turn, stalked inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, was between horses in upper stretch and weakened.

CALL ME LATER angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the turn and again off heels in upper stretch and was edged for third three deep on the line. TAHOE YODELER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong but was edged late for third. WARRENS HEARTTHROB broke out and bumped a rival then came in onto foes, steadied off heels early, chased off the rail then outside a rival to

the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TROUBLE RULES a bit slow to begin, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and improved position. CURLY BOY angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. DESTINED JOURNEY in tight early, chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BOLD FRESH sent between horses then dueled three deep or outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn, was brushed into the stretch and weakened. RED MOUNTAIN between horses early, settled inside, came out on the turn and again into the stretch and was not a threat. BEER FRIDAY a bit slow to begin and steadied in tight in the opening strides, angled in and settled just off the rail and was outrun.
