CONNAGHER moved up immediately on the rail to take a slim early lead, maintained the advantage around the turn, opened up some at the furlong marker and held on in the final yards. SAMMY'S A RUNNIN' stalked on the inside around the turn, remained inside to the final furlong, rallied between horses in the late stages and gained the place. OAK KYE WHY pulled his way along to press the pacesetter on the outside to the stretch, weakened in the final furlong and lost the place in the final yards. DANA DYNAMO was without any early speed, angled outside in the stretch and passed tiring foes in the final furlong. WARRING HEART chased on the outside down the backstretch, was asked for his best at the quarter pole and failed to respond in the lane. BOLD TYPE stalked inside in the early stages then off the rail into the turn, was in a comfortable striking position entering the lane but had no rally in the stretch.

RAETODANDTY sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, kicked clear and held on gamely under urging. WILDCAT NATION broke a bit slowly, was sent up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch, could not catch the winner but was game for the place. UNIONIZE stalked off the rail then outside a rival, split horses in midstretch and held third. DREAM NOW pulled between horses on the backstretch and was in a bit tight nearing the turn, continued inside on the bend, swung out into the stretch and was edged for the show. MAJESTIC AFLEET stalked between horses then outside into and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PICO PICO angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BASILE PREMIER hesitated to be away slowly, pulled his way along off the rail then outside a rival, angled to the inside into the stretch and did not rally. QUOTED was in a good position stalking the pace four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened.

MISSILETTE had good early speed and duelled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under some urging. DARLING DISARRAY between foes early, duelled outside the winner, stalked off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and held second. SPARROW steadied when crowded on the backstretch, chased a bit off the rail then inside, split horses in midstretch and edged a rival for third. LUCKY SIS broke inward, chased outside then off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and was edged for the show. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn and again into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DARLING CIANA broke slowly, came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. LEMON DROP RIDGE dropped back outside on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and lacked the necessary response. ELOQUENCE stalked inside, was in a bit tight into the turn, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the

stretch and weakened. NATURAL PEARL shuffled back a bit in the early going, chased off the rail or outside, came three deep into the stretch and was not a factor. PLANET JANET chased between horses then off the inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. MAMA'S SPELL broke outward and slowly, angled in on the backstretch, found the rail on the turn and was outrun. AMOR DE MI ALMA broke a bit awkwardly, was sent along a bit off the rail early, continued outside a rival into the stretch and failed to menace.

NO STADIUM stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, took the lead in upper stretch, kicked clear under a steady hand ride and a long hold late. DAVE'S RULER between foes early, stalked three deep, went four wide into the second turn and three wide into the stretch and picked up the place. CASA O allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the second turn, swung three deep into the stretch and just got the show. ROYAL DREAM sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn, offered little resistance when the winner challenged in the stretch but just lost third. LEYVA MAN broke out a bit, settled outside then off the rail, continued outside on the backstretch and second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and improved position with a late bid at a minor award. PROMISE NO MORE pulled his way along inside chasing the

pace, remained on the rail throughout and lacked the needed rally. BODY BUILDER pulled his way along to chase between horses then a bit off the rail on the second turn and weakened. PARTY AT MY PLACE pulled between horses to press the pace, continued outside the pacesetter early on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. TIZEXCHANGE four wide into the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival and lacked a rally. LUNAR HALO a bit slow to begin, raced unhurried a bit off the rail early, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. HAMONIC MOTION four wide into the first turn, settled outside or off the rail and failed to menace. STIMULUS PACKAGE pulled his way along between horses then stalked three deep, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
