RON BOB AND DAVE was fractious in the gate prior to the start, bobbled shortly after the start, moved up inside leaving the chute, was angled outside the pacesetter entering the turn and was able to gradually wear down that one while being floated out some in the late stages. UNCLE JEEP pulled his way to the early lead leaving the chute, retained a clear advantage to midstretch, came out slightly in the final sixteenth and was worn down in the final strides. OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) chased outside DOPPIO for most of the journey and was able to gain the show in the final furlong while no real threat for the major award. DOPPIO chased inside OUR NAUTIQUE for most of the trip and was outfinished by that one in the stretch drive.

CAMICORY stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and held gamely under urging. CANTONA leaned forward just before the start but broke with the field, pulled three deep into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came out some in the stretch and finished with interest between foes. OUTRAGEOUS FORTUNE allowed to settle just off the rail, came out in upper stretch and put in a late bid three deep on the line. CAT BRANDO chased a bit off the inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and bested the others. LEYVA MAN broke a bit slowly, angled in and chased inside then just off the fence, found the inside again in the lane, was a bit crowded behind the pacesetter in midstretch and again a sixteenth out before going around that one late. SKIMMING SKIPPER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in upper stretch, drifted in then out in the final furlong while weakening and dropped back. SWISS EMPEROR four wide into the first turn, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened.
