AUTOCUE (GB) lost the rider during the warm-up and ran loose for about a quarter of a mile, was reserved during the early running, chased inside down the backstretch, moved up on the second turn, entered the stretch four wide and rallied down the middle of the track to gain the score on the wire. SUPER HARMONY crossed over to take the lead into the first turn, retained a clear advantage to the stretch, battled past mid-stretch and was overtaken on the wire in a game effort. PREMIERE FLYER stalked outside a rival down the backstretch and around the second turn, was asked for his best at the quarter pole and failed to gain sufficient ground in the final furlong while holding the show. DON'T YA LOVETT (NZ) saved ground around the first turn, continued on the inside down the backstretch and around the second turn, improved his position on the wood in the final furlong and just lost third at the wire. SMOOTH AND SAVVY stalked inside a rival down the backstretch, came off the rail for the drive and could not make up the needed ground. FILM FORTUNE was off a bit slowly, chased outside down the backstretch, moved up some on the second turn, entered the lane three wide and flattened out in the final furlong.

SHE'S NOT LION stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain the lead and inched away late under a strong hand ride. GIRLWITHTHEGOLDHOOF sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside on the backstretch while the saddled slipped forward some, inched away on the turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. PRINCESS BEAU K pulled her way along to chase the pace inside, came out into the stretch and clearly bested the others. READY FOR CROWDS chased three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive. OTTO'S FAST LIL pulled alongside a rival then bid outside the pacesetter and dueled for the lead, dropped back on the turn, came out into the stretch and gave way. ST. PATTI'S DAY a bit slow to begin, chased between horses then outside a rival, angled in on the turn, gave way readily in the stretch and was eased late.

SPURRIER chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and again in the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up and get up on the wire. NEVER saved ground early then came a bit off the fence to chase the pace, angled out in upper stretch, rallied to the front under pressure in deep stretch and held on well but could not quite contain the winner. ONE TRACK MIND sped to the early lead, set the pace just off the rail then inside, dueled into and on the second turn, inched clear again in the stretch, fought back in deep stretch, could not match the top pair late but clearly bested the others. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) angled in and stalked inside then off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into and on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. DELIGHTFUL KISS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out some in the stretch and failed to menace.

LYONS BARTON sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set all the pace inside, turned back the bid of the runner-up under urging in the stretch and won clear. GREELY'S GHOST close up stalking the winner off the rail then outside a rival, continued off the inside in the stretch and held second. EZE DOES IT between horses early, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for the place. GALLETA MONSTRUO pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, chased between foes on the backstretch and off the rail on the second turn, split rivals in deep stretch and was edged for a minor award. SUREFIRE well placed stalking the pace along the inside throughout, lacked the needed late response. COME IN ALMIGHTY angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. BROTHER LOUIE three deep into the first turn, stalked outside on the backstretch and second turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened.
