MANY CROWS up close and saving ground into the turn, raced three wide into the stretch and also finished gamely. CHAPEL OF LOVE moved up inside nearing the half mile pole, reached the front on the turn and raced off the rail into the lane brushing with a rival, battled then yielded grudgingly. BIG TEXAS DADDY raced near the rail on the turn and through the lane and finished willingly while needing more. GREATSILVERSAINT bobbled soon after the start, saved ground and lacked the needed late response. AMEN BABY vied early and in the three path into the turn, raced four wide into the stretch and tired. A claim of foul by the rider of CHAPEL OF LOVE against the winner for interference soon after the start was not allowed.
