ACTION NINE kept in touch with the front runner and tracked that one into the stretch while off the rail, rallied outside in the run to the wire, caught the leader and prevailed under good urging. BLING BLING QUEEN had speed to lead the way, was in the three path and in charge turning for home, kept on the engine to mid stretch then could not match the outside rally of the winner and settled for second best. SOY SAUCE had an inside trip and was a factor from the rail into the stretch, bid from there and finished off a good effort. COZY FIRE up on the pace, tracked the speed into the stretch from off the rail then evened out in the drive. WEEKEND PASSION had an outside trip, was wide into the stretch then lacked the needed kick. SEASTRIKE was between foes early, angled out to be in the five path into the stretch then lacked the late punch. GILDED ROYALE saved ground from off the pace and did not threaten. SALANDER hit the gate at the break and was off very slow, then raced wide and trailed the field throughout.

GIGANTOS outside foes in the early going, closed and bid four wide turning for home, led into mid stretch then was outfinished to the wire. PERFECT CHEROKEE stalked the pacesetters, bid from the four path into the stretch after angling out, then angled out for clear sailing in the run to the wire and finished off a good effort. MIAMI DECO made an early move and was three wide and dueling into the far turn, vied into the stretch from there then tired inside foes in the drive. SCRAM DIGGITY tracked the early leader then went up to press from between foes, vied on the far turn then faltered. BEAR IN CONTROL had speed to lead the way out of the clubhouse turn and opened a gap, was challenged into the far turn, vied inside into the stretch then faded. SARATOGA THUNDER saved ground on the far turn while trailing then failed to bid. HOLY KNIGHT off the pace, bolted going into the far turn, was pulled up and did not finish.

BANG FOR THE BUCK was an inside factor into the stretch then gave way in the drive. MI PLAYA led the way into and through the turn then faltered. AVAMORE saved ground then had no bid while trailing the field home.
