DEEVEETEE, rated midpack, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. MOMMIE WHIZ, well back early, was hustled two to four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. MAGICALCARPETRIDE pressed the pace to the turn, dropped back but stayed in striking range to the stretch and tired.

NOT SO GRIEM dueled early but was headed late backstretch, rebid early turn, vied then was headed by WHERE'S RINGO at the top of the stretch, regained the lead a furlong out and widened under a drive. WHERE'S RINGO raced midpack two-wide, closed along the rail leaving the turn, drove to the lead at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner and was all out to save the place. SIN OF OMISSION showed brief speed and was taken back out of the duel, stalked four and five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. HAMEISH raced midpack, chased four-wide late turn then evened out in the final 16th. TAKE A PITCH raced midpack, chased five and six-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. MOJITO raced off the pace, closed to midpack nearing the turn, was hustled six-wide but never threatened. KING NAIVE bobbled at the start and was steadied, moved up quickly to duel, led briefly late backstretch then was engaged and dueled through the turn but tired at the top of the stretch. FAGAN, well back early, was roused through the turn but had no response. SWEEPING UPA STORM raced off the pace, was hustled angling from three to six-wide through the turn then lacked a rally.

HALTON GULLY stalked the pace, chased the new leader from midturn and was best of the rest. CARBON FOOTPRINT raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn, lugged in through the stretch ducking in several times and evened out. MONEYONTHEGRASS moved clear late backstretch, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch, hung briefly then finished gamely with a strong late effort. MAXIOM, off slowly, raced three and four-wide, chased late turn and finished determinedly in vain. BRALORNE was hustled early and gained midpack, saved ground on the turn but evened out in the stretch. RIMAL AL SAHARA, in range early, came three and four-wide through the turn, dropped back past midturn and lacked a rally.
