CARNACKS CHOICE, reserved in hand just off the first flight along the inside in the opening quarter, continued under some reserve awaiting an opening after a half, switched out three deep in upper stretch and responded to right handed urging to collar the pacesetter on the wire. WHAT DO YOU MEAN broke sharply and to a clear advantage, dictated the pace near the inside to upper stretch, turned back a challenger to extend his advantage past the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner. STAN THE TAP MAN was urged to secure a forward placing just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, tracked that foe on the bend, advanced to challenge nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the leader and weakened late DIAMOND STEAL was settled along the inside racing through the backstretch, was roused to challenge racing into upper stretch while continuing near the inside and made some mild progress late. CURE tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight, made a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly gave way.

SURFER ROSA took up a tracking position four wide in second flight in the opening stages, angled sharply to the rail on the turn, made steady progress inside foes to upper stretch and produced a solid late response to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing the wire and just edge that foe under strong handling. HEAVENS CHEER broke sharply, set the pace near the inside racing into the bend, went well clear in upper stretch but just failed to sustain her momentum in the final sixteenth. BROKEN TRUST FUND tracked the leaders three wide between foes as part of the second flight, angled to the inside entering the bend, followed the eventual winner's path along the rail racing through the stretch and was making steady progress late. RAVIN LUNATIC, a bit unruly in the gate before the start, chased the leaders near the inside into upper stretch, shifted out a bit racing through the lane but had no final kick. RECIPIENT was roused to contend in the opening stages, shifted out making some progress racing through the turn, raced four wide through the stretch but had no final response. PECOSA chased the pacesetter off the inside into the turn, couldn't gain terms with that foe and gave way in the last furlong. MONTY'S DREAM tracked the pace between foes in second flight and continued evenly into the stretch. CANYON SHADOWS, a bit slow into stride, angled inwards but never gained contention. WRAPPED IN GOLD broke last and never mounted a serious challenge. KELA AVENUE was settled near the inside and never menaced thereafter. EUROPA'S RAP was pulled up after taking an awkward step on the turn and was vanned off the course.

SEELYALATERATER angled inwards in the opening stages racing under reserve just off the second flight near the inside, shifted out on the backstretch to continue between foes under rating, angled to the inside on the second bend while awaiting an opening after six furlongs, shifted four wide to split foes leaving the furlong marker and continued with a steady response to wrest command in time under firm handling. HOLLY AT LAW tracked three deep behind the second flight to the backstretch, advanced in that path to split foes leaving the far turn, moved to challenge in upper stretch, gained the lead between calls late but couldn't contain the winner. POBRECITA tracked just off the leaders along the inside while unhurried in the opening half, continued in hand while shifting off the inside on the far turn, raced in traffic nearing the quarter mile marker while lacking a path from which to challenge, angled six wide entering upper stretch and was making steady progress late. SARAHTHETIGER tracked the leaders unhurried from well out of striking distance along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn while making a six wide rally to contention nearing the quarter mile marker, shifted in to dispute the lead three deep racing through the stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. VAULTS LAST SISTER angled in to lead the second flight along the inside, continued along the rail to upper stretch but had no final response. SHESA TOUGH KITTY, caught four wide racing through the first turn, advanced outside foes to make a brief, four wide bid between rivals nearing upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. LIPSTICK LADY, reserved well off the pace along the inside in the opening half, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position but made no impression on the leaders. STIVERS

SUPRISE was settled along the inside in the last flight early, continued in hand near the rail into upper stretch and couldn't menace when lacking a path from which to advance. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER tracked just off the pacesetter to the backstretch, pressed that foe on the far turn and emptied out in upper stretch. SENSATIONAL GOLD urged to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace to upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. SHAQUITA was held up outside foes racing to the backstretch, swung out five wide leaving the far turn and soon proved empty. GLORY BELLE tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight, made a brief, three wide bid between foes on the far turn and emptied out abruptly after six furlongs.
