STARDUST RAJ secured terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, dictated the tempo along the rail racing into the bend on a narrow margin, then held the challenge of STEP SISTER through the final stages under firm encouragement. The latter was held up just off the leaders in the opening stages, angled inwards after a half moving into striking position, shifted out bumping CLASSIC CHOICE approaching the five sixteenths marker, moved to challenge the leader entering upper stretch but proved only second best. CLASSIC CHOICE stalked just off the pace between foes in the opening half, was bumped midway through the bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. THAT'S A STORY flashed brief pace outside foes but steadily faded from contention on the turn.

ADELIA was urged to the lead outside rivals racing into the first turn, angled to the rail once clear, dictated the pace under rating on a narrow margin into the second bend, then edged forward in late stages under firm handling. GOLDEN TEARDROP, bumped at the start, was reserved just off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering the far turn, angled out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued well outside foes to secure the place while not quite gaining terms with the winner. LIGHT MY SAPPHIRE reserved in hand off the second flight in the opening stages, advanced to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn, closed the gap on the winner late and was narrowly outfinished for the place while edging a rival for a share on the wire. OCCULTATION raced unhurried just off the second flight into the first turn, advanced three deep entering the backstretch to gain terms with the pacesetter, prompted that foe racing through the far turn and was just outkicked for a share. PASSADE gained a forward placing racing to the first turn, stalked the pacesetter between foes in second flight to the backstretch, made a brief bid racing through the far turn and flattened out in upper stretch. SHE'S A GRINDER, reserved along the inside to the backstretch, shifted outside foes to make a brief, four wide bid on the far turn but dropped out nearing upper stretch. PHANTOM STAR broke outwards bumping GOLDEN TEARDROP, was quickly righted to gain a stalking position along the inside, raced just off the pacesetter to the far turn and steadily faded along the inside.

WAKEUPBRANDON joined the pace outside a rival from the break, pressed that rival while gaining a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge but proved only second best. BLACK PATCH was urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command inside a rival into upper stretch but was outfinished by the top pair.

DEACON PAPA PETE was urged to secure a forward placing along the inside racing to the bend while just off the leaders, angled out three deep in upper stretch to challenge, took over leaving the furlong marker and held the challenge of COOL HEART under firm handling. The latter worked his way to the inside, saved ground as part of the second flight to upper stretch, shifted off the inside to split foes in the final sixteenth, bid inside the winner but proved only second best. NO GOOD DEED steadied a bit in close quarters in the opening stages, continued a bit erratically along the rail racing well off the pace entering the bend, saved ground to upper stretch, was guided outside foes to race five wide nearing the furlong marker and produced his best stride late. GRECIAN PARADISE tracked the leaders outside foes as part of the second flight, then continued evenly into upper stretch. IL FORO was hustled to the lead, set the pace along the rail racing into the turn, dueled inside a rival to upper stretch and gave way late. WILLIE PREVAIL, bumped at the start, was quickly collected, then urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, prompted that foe to midstretch and gave way in late stages. PLATINUM HUNTER broke inwards bumping WILLIE PREVAIL, was collected off that foe to track the pace racing three deep to the bend just off the second flight, but steadily faded nearing the lane. OWEN THE TIGER was settled off the inside between foes racing to the bend but never mounted a serious challenge. DAKOTA METT tracked the pace between foes near the inside racing into the bend, was carried out a bit entering upper stretch and lacked any further response. SHARP ROMA trailed.

PRAIRIE PRIZE tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the bend, couldn't match that foe's tempo after five furlongs but continued with some interest to earn a share. SHELTERED, reserved along the inside early, angled four wide racing into the turn to make some brief progress but flattened out leaving midstretch. LA COLORADA, caught four wide approaching the first turn, was wrangled back entering the bend to track outside foes, advanced with a sharp, four wide move entering the far turn to challenge, continued in that path to upper stretch but flattened out. POWER BOUND worked her way to the inside after the opening furlong, was held up along the inside nearing upper stretch, shifted in and out in traffic approaching the furlong marker but made an effort to improve her position late. SUSIE LARK, caught a bit wide racing into the first turn, angled in to track the leaders outside a rival in second flight to the far turn, bid three wide between foes racing through the second bend and emptied out in upper stretch. ONE WINK moved to the fore along the inside, disputed the pace inside a rival into upper stretch and gave way. SUE'S ALY CAT angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. MONA MONA, caught a bit wide early, never mounted a serious challenge. GREATEST STAR trailed.
