U TURN ME CRAZY broke alertly, forced then stalked the pace on the inside down the backstretch, split horses entering the stretch, battled between foes to the wire and was up for a game win. REAL HOUSEWIFE duelled between foes then inside down the backstretch, showed the way into the stretch, battled on the inside to the wire and lost a close decision. SCRATCHTHEMOON stalked off the rail into the turn, moved up three deep on the turn, came into the stretch three wide, battled to the wire on the outside of a three horse spread, was outfinished but gamely held third. JANA GAIL broke through the gate prior to the start, broke alertly then settled down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, remained on the wood for the drive improved her position in the late stages. IDA OF MARCH stalked on the inside into the turn, came outside around the turn, entered the lane four wide and lacked the needed rally in the final furlong. MARY STRONG was reserved down the backstretch, came into the stretch five wide and could not make an impact in the lane. SAMBISTA duelled for the lead on the outside to the quarter pole, was squeezed between horses approaching the stretch and fell back through the drive.

SCOFIELD BARRACKS settled off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied for the place. ROCKIN ZOLA sped to the early lead, set the pace just off the rail, fought back when challenged leaving the turn and into the stretch, inched away again in midstretch, battled outside the winner in deep stretch, could not match that one late and was edged for second. GENTLE ROMEO stalked outside then three deep, bid alongside ROCKIN ZOLA leaving the turn and into the stretch, lugged inward through the drive and weakened. LIT'SGOODLOOKNGRAY chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRIBAL JUSTICE chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and weakened. DETROIT DONNIE close up stalking the pace off the rail then between horses to the stretch and also weakened.

SEA RASCAL stalked outside then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained the lead under left handed urging six wide past the eighth pole, drifted in and held gamely. LEANDROS (FR) chased between horses, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, was in tight off heels and angled inward nearing midstretch, bid between foes and continued gamely to the wire. BRENTHURST chased inside throughout, bid along the rail in the stretch and continued willingly to best the others. EXCLAMATION (GB) had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back between horses in midstretch and until deep stretch and weakened some late. TALL TEXAN stalked between horses, went three deep on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch and also weakened late. PARTY MANDATE angled in and dueled outside a rival then between foes on the turn and until past midstretch and weakened. INCURABLE LOU (ARG) went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DOPPIO between foes early, chased off the rail then outside, came out five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. GOLD STAR STATUS hopped slightly and threw his head in a bit of a slow start, pulled between horses and steadied when rank off heels a half mile out, continued between foes on the turn and weakened in the stretch.

GO FORTH NORTH in a bit tight early, chased inside, came out for room on the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied to the front while drifting in a bit past midstretch and gamely prevailed. NOT HERE four wide on the first turn, chased outside, continued four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, rallied between foes in the drive, steadied in a bit tight off heels in late stretch but continued willingly. TIZALWAYSOMETHING had speed between horses then stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead in the drive, fought back between horses past midstretch and to the wire and held third. LILLY'S PERFECT pulled her way along to stalk between horses, bid between foes past midstretch, came in onto the pacesetter a sixteenth out and was outfinished. LIVE AND LOVE also pulled and stalked inside, split horses into the stretch and continued willingly but could not quite summon the necessary response. SPANISH BUNNY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. LEMONY FRESH pulled her way along three deep then inched away and angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, battled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, fell back some and was forced into the gap at the chute a sixteenth out and weakened. KICKEN OFF also pulled early, chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels in deep stretch and lacked the necessary rally. CANDY'S AFFAIR settled off the pace and angled in, found the inside on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. LA RAPIDEZ broke in a bit, was sent between foes then pulled under a hold, angled in and stalked inside, was in tight along the rail into the stretch and weakened.
