CACTUS JANE chased inside a rival into the turn, saved ground around the turn, rallied inside the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and was drawing away at the finish. LAKE BELIEVE chased outside a rival into and around the turn, came into the lane three wide and rallied on the outside to gain the pace in the late stages. JENNY JENNY EMILY crossed over from the outside post to take the early lead, crowded a rival on the backstretch, maintained a clear advantage in midstretch while drifting out and weakened in the final furlong. SLANE CASTLE chased on the inside around the turn, remained inside for the drive and failed to threaten for the major awards. FORTY PACES steadied inside JENNY JENNY EMILY on the backstretch, angled outside that one on the turn, came into the lane between rivals and weakened in the final furlong. BENEZIA raced between horses into the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch drive. FIL'SLASTSCORE chased three deep into the turn and was without a bid when asked at the top of the lane. WARREN'S NATALIE lacked early speed and failed to make an impact. Following a stewards' inquiry, JENNY JENNY EMILY was disqualified and placed fifth for interference on the backstretch.

FLEMINGSTOUCHOGOLD settled outside, advanced four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch to gain the lead, drifted in when clear under urging and held between foes late. WARRENS WILD THING unhurried along the inside early, saved ground on the turn, waited off heels nearing the stretch, slipped through in tight quarters along the rail in upper stretch and finished well on the fence to just miss. ANGA broke slowly ,settled just off the rail, came out leaving the turn, steadied then swung six wide into the stretch and rallied three deep on the line. OUR JUKE BOX HERO pulled between horses then chased off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came out seven wide into the stretch and bested the rest. QUIETLY WAITING chased off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in past midstretch and lacked a rally. RESPLENDENTLY dueled three deep between horses, came out into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S DOVE had good early speed and dueled between foes, came out some into the stretch and also weakened. SWONGS prompted the pace four wide, came five wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. SKIMMING SKIPPER stalked outside then three deep, continued off the rail, angled in some in the stretch and lacked a further response. MAGICAL INSTINCT went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, steadied between horses in upper stretch and gave way.

LUCIUS ANTONIUS stalked a bit off the rail then inside, continued toward the rail in the stretch and lacked a late response. AUTOCUE (GB) settled outside then alongside a rival, came out on the second turn, was fanned six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GOLD TRIM unhurried off the rail early, went three deep on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn, was floated five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. DAY WITH DESI sped to the early lead, set the pace inside then a bit off the rail, steadied in tight off the heels of the riderless horse into the second turn, dropped back between foes leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch. VICTORIAN PRINCE (IRE) stumbled badly at the start and lost the rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into

the start before ruling VICTORIAN PRINCE was the cause of his own trouble.
