MISS REDITORE settled into stride down the backstretch, began to move closer on the turn, swung out four wide at the top of the stretch and rallied on the outside to gain the victory on the wire. GONE REBEL moved up inside to open a clear lead on the backstretch, retained the advantage around the turn, was under right handed urging in the final eighth and denied right on the wire. CATHY'S CRUNCHES chased outside a rival in the early stages, was three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the necessary kick in the final furlong. SWISS WILD CAT chased inside a rival in the early stages, continued to save ground around the turn, angled outside the pacesetter at the top of the lane, came back in inside the furlong marker and could not make up the needed ground. HI HO YODELER was nearest the pacesetter down the backstretch, entered the stretch between horses and fell back in the stretch drive.

GRAND MISCHIEF close up stalking the pace inside, bid along the rail on the turn to take a short lead, fought back a bit off the fence in the stretch, inched away past midstretch and held gamely under urging. LUTESS prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked alongside the winner on the backstretch and outside foe on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished willingly. MISS PICABOO sped to the early lead, inched away just off the fence a half mile out, dueled alongside the winner on the turn and in the stretch and held third between foes late. PRIMED chased off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. DANCINCONESTRELLAS a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then angled inside leaving the backstretch, continued along the fence on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LINE ONE three deep early, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, drifted inward in the final furlong and did not rally. FIFTY CARATS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in some leaving the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat.

DE CAR GUY chased off the rail, angled in for the turn, came a bit off the fence on the bend, angled out in the stretch and finished well to gain the place three deep on the wire. CAJUN GENT sped to the early lead, set the pace along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted out despite right handed urging in late stretch and was caught between foes late. DEFYING LOGIC between rivals early, stalked outside a foe then off the rail leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and continued willingly while in a bit close off heels on the line. DON'T YA LOVETT (NZ) chased just off the rail then inside into and on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CONGA ROCK between horses early, stalked outside a foe, came out some into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. NENE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally.

NO AFILLYATION bumped between horses at the start, stalked between foes or outside a rival, bid alongside the runner-up on the turn and three deep in midstretch and weakened but held third. E Z LED broke in and bumped a rival, chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. REAL HEART stalked three deep on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. MONEY INCLUDED bumped between horses and squeezed at the start, chased just off the rail on the backstretch and turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and lacked a further response.

ACCELERANT chased inside then between horses on the backstretch, continued three deep between foes on the second turn, rallied under urging three wide to gain the lead in late stretch and held between rivals late. TRIBAL NATION angled in and settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and finished well three deep on the wire. SAMMARTINO had speed outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came a bit off the rail then drifted inward in midstretch, fought back to regain a short advantage past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. MARINO'S STAR pulled a bit and stalked the pace inside, lacked room leaving the second turn, waited a bit in midstretch then steadied off heels nearing the sixteenth pole, found room inside late and continued willingly. UNKNOWN HEAT also pulled and drifted out a bit on the first turn, bid three deep a half mile out then outside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch, put a head in front in midstretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened some late. MINISTER D'ORO saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and again nearing midstretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. MEDITERRANO pulled his way along inside then stalked off the rail, bid between horses a half mile out, tracked the leaders between foes on the second turn, was in a bit close off heels in deep stretch and lacked the needed late response. WARREN'S ROUGH LUV also pulled early, chased outside, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. TIZZYS DESERT STAR allowed to settle off the pace inside then just out from the rail to the stretch and did not rally.
