BROOKIE GIRL was bumped at the start, stalked inside a rival down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, slipped through inside the pacesetter at the top of the lane and drew out in the final furlong. HIT THE BRIX chased inside a rival down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, remained on the wood for the drive and rallied to be best of the rest. SKY MARNI chased outside a foe down the backstretch, remained outside around the turn, steadied briefly at the quarter pole, came into the lane four wide and lacked the necessary rally in the final furlong. ULTRA AWESOME stalked outside the winner down the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide and weakened in the final eighth. MOONSHINE ALICE was bumped at the start, moved up to duel on the inside down the backstretch, opened up some around the turn, came into the lane between horses and weakened in the stretch drive. FANATICAL (GB) broke outward at the start, dueled outside MOONSHINE ALICE down the backstretch, began to weaken approaching the stretch, was caught five wide into the lane and fell back in the drive.

MICHAILASHEARTLITE bobbled at the start, settled outside a rival then off the rail, went outside on the turn, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. D' ELEGANCE pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside and steadied off heels a half mile out, continued inside on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. ONENIGHTIN BEIJING broke in a bit, had speed between foes then dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch.

LOVELY SOPHIA three deep early, angled in and settled off the pace inside, split horses leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch and surged three deep in late stretch. KAYSA DEEYA pulled her way to the early lead outside then alongside a rival, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, inched clear again in the stretch and held on well but was overtaken nearing the line. PIOUS DAVID bumped at the start, stalked off the rail, split horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch and narrowly bested that one late under urging. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE angled in early and dueled three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and continued gamely to the wire. OLYMPIC MAGIC also angled in early and stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and edged foes for the show. ABSOLUTE MAGNITUDE fractious in the post parade, bobbled

and broke out onto a rival, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, continued outside on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and just missed the show. KELA'S ASSAULT steadied off heels early, chased outside or off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HAPPY HEDGER bobbled in a slow start, then was shut off, settled inside, came out in the stretch, was in tight off heels past midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. OBSESS had good early speed and dueled between horses then inside leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. SOUVENIR SUMMER a bit fractious in the gate, was between foes early, stalked off the rail then inside on the turn, came out around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OLY'S OFFSPRING steadied when squeezed back at the start, was rank between horses then outside a rival into the turn and did not rally. COOKIN EXPRESSO broke out onto foes, went up inside to duel for the lead, fell back in a bit tight past midway on the turn and weakened. MIKETH DEALER steadied off heels in the early stages and dropped back off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
