ABILIO was last away then asked a bit from the start, moved up on the outside to take the lead, crossed to the rail entering the first turn, drew off to a commanding lead, extended the lead even further on the backstretch, was set down leaving the final turn, remained well clear while under strong urging into the final furlong then was eased up in the final sixteenth while never threatened. JOEY'S CHANCE was taken in hand early then reserved on the inside, saved ground while in second position through both turns, was finally roused near the quarter-pole and secured the place while never a threat to the winner. THUNDER CHIEF went two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced off the rail on the far turn, was roused near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. TOM KITTEN settled on the inside, was roused while continuing to save ground on the far turn and failed to rally. BARREL OF LOVE raced under a tight hold while two to three wide on the first turn, steadied late on that turn, was reserved well off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten. FRANKLIN DELANO bumped with a rival at the start, moved out nearing the first turn, went two then three wide on that turn, moved to four wide into the backstretch, settled well back in the field, raced off the rail on the final turn, was roused near the top of the stretch and was no factor. GAMBLIN FEVER bobbled a bit at the start then was bumped on both sides, raced inside then off the rail on the first turn, lagged near the rear of the field, was roused on the far turn and was no factor. MR. HOOKER was fractious and charged the front of the gate but came away in good order, saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field and showed little. SPEAKING OUT raced just off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under a ride while saving ground on the far turn and failed to respond. WISHINGONADREAM bumped with a rival at the start, was taken back between rivals early then eased to the outside, went three to four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and came up empty. (Rail at 18 Feet)

FISCAL STIMULUS away well from the starting gate, was mildly urged to assume a forward position, engaged in a spirited tussle with ESPIRITO SANTO while taking the inside route. was asked for a bit more heading for the stretch, shook free during the run through the furlongs grounds, then staved off the late-closing runner up under a vigorous hand ride. ENDER'S UNIVERSE off the inside, was put to a prolonged drive and finished with good courage to garner place honors. PROMOVEDOR GLORY (ARG) off the inside, responded positively when roused in upper lane, altered course several paths over to the inside in the vicinity of the sixteenth and completed the race with good late energy en route for the show. ESPIRITO SANTO dueled with the winner from the two path until upper stretch before backing off. COACH BILLY G. broke awkwardly and improved by mainly weak ones during the stretch drive. WILD HERO off a beat slowly, was put to a hard drive, angled off the inside coming to the eighth pole but lacked could make no headway on the top one. CON THE CAT raced three wide and outrun. KIDD (GER) running for purse money only, underwent a ground-saving journey and tired.

PROCLAIM broke outward at the start then was asked a bit to get the lead, set the pace while nicely rated on the inside, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, shook clear off DATTT ECHO shortly thereafter, held the lead into the final furlong but was quickly collared then proved no match for the winner but was clear for the place. HIT IT RICH settled on the outside, was urged a bit near the half-mile pole, raced three wide while under some urging on the turn, came under a more vigorous ride in upper stretch and capitulated but managed to get the show. DATTT ECHO bobbled ever so slightly at the start, stalked the leader on the outside, remained at that rivals hindquarters while off the rail on the turn, was asked for run near the quarter-pole and came up empty then gave way. NORTH RODEO was well placed near the rail, saved ground and was roused on the turn, came up empty in upper stretch and faded. COLOR ME UP was off slow then drifted inward in the early going, settled at the back of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and faltered.
