YANKEE FORTUNE crossed over after the start, dropped to the rail nearing the first turn and impeded TAPIT'S BREW, raced inside on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, stalked the lead on the outside, ranged up to take the lead outside the quarter-pole, responded well when put to a drive, drifted in while moving clear near the furlong marker and proved much the best under left hand urging. PEAHI saved ground on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was roused while off the rail midway through the turn, came into the stretch under vigorous urging and finished willingly to get the place late. DOUBLE EAGLE (ARG) raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response and missed the place. TAPIT'S BREW was shut-off by the winner nearing the first turn and steadied, moved off the rail on that turn then took over the lead, set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead approaching the quarter-pole and gave way. VERSAILLES ROAD was reserved near the back of the field, raced two to three wide on the turns, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. ROUND ABOUT was taken up a bit while awkwardly into stride after the break, raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, moved out on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ZAPSTER was hard held while very rank early, continued rank while four wide on the first turn, settled a bit on the backstretch, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. MIZZEN'S WAKE raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up early on the backstretch, was well placed behind the leader, saved ground on the far turn, came up empty when roused coming to the quarter-pole and dropped out. After the race, the rider of TAPIT'S BREW lodged an objection against the rider of YANKEE FORTUNE for interference nearing the first turn. Following the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 18 Feet)

HYSTERICAL CAT was hustled away from the starting gate, went head to head briefly with READ THE CONTRACT before disposing of that one, motored around the bend while travelling along the inside, drew off to a commanding advantage after being set down in upper stretch and held sway while being kept busy to the end. CREA'S LAW off to an alert beginning, was outsprinted by a pair of rivals in short order, took up chase from the two path under encouragement, ducked over to the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, showed a quick acceleration of speed to gain a contending position, angled sharply three wide into upper stretch, carrying out COUSIN FRANKIE a bit, continued his rally, lacked the needed bid to reel in his entry mate, but displayed enough to procure the place. SAILMATE outrun while racing along the outside, came home with a mild rally to be along for the show. COOPER RIVER saved ground until the eighth pole and was never a menace. FOR WES three wide around the turn, was steadied turning for home, when COUSIN FRANKIE was pushed over into his path, angled outward a couple of strides later, came up empty when called upon. COUSIN FRANKIE lightly coaxed along to keep pace with front runners, was forced out a bit by the runner up heading for the stretch, steadily tired thereafter. READ THE CONTRACT broke out a bit, was urged to assume a forward position, briefly went head to head with the top one, backed off and returned bleeding.

TOO BIG TO FAIL was bumped in the hindquarters at the start then taken in hand early, settled in the middle of the field while off the rail, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead late and prevailed under good handling. R J HOPE raced inside on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, was asked to pick it up a bit near the half-mile, came under a more vigorous ride midway through the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well to pick up the place near the wire. ROCK AMERICA was rated inside on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, settled in third, ranged up while two to three wide on the far turn, gained the lead passing the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong but was overtaken then caught for the place near the wire. ENCHANTED CIRCLE (GB) moved in to save ground nearing the first turn, settled on the inside, was roused while continuing to save ground on the far turn, came out at the top of the stretch and finished willingly. JUDICIAL LEADER sped off from the competition under her power to open up a commanding lead by the time she went a half, continued along on the loose lead around the far turn, saw the margin dwindle down, offered some resistance before yielding in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but continued onward with good energy to earn the show. KALEIGH ROSE bumped at the start, was rank between rivals nearing the first turn, acted more kindly after being settled into the backstretch, raced in midpack, although far off the leader, was taken in hand while in tight around the five-sixteenths pole, responded well in upper stretch when the opportunity to be called upon finally presented itself closed in, lost a bit of momentum when the runner up angled out midstretch, then finished with good courage during the final furlong to grab the last major share. PALACE MISTRESS bumped between rivals at the start, was guided over to the inside soon afterwards, took the inside route thereafter, was put to a strong drive after entering the stretch, but lacked a solid offering. QUEEN OF PROTOCOL was squeezed back at the start, entered the backstretch from the three path, remained towards the back of the pack and failed to reach a contending position. HOLY MOMENT raced along the inside during the initial going, futilely tried to slip into the two path all along the backstretch, but was denied, when the riders of both KALEIGH ROSE and OUR MISS BROOKSIDE firmly held their ground, found room to maneuver three wide turning for home, rallied mildly but was outkicked leaving the eighth pole. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE lightly bumped at the start, was floated three wide by a rank rival nearing the opening bend, remained in the three path until quarter pole, and steadily tired.

MAMBO MEISTER bumped with a rival at the start and was brushed by GAYEGO, moved up to race just behind the leader, raced just off the rail on the turn, was carried inward in upper stretch and tired while drifting out in the final furlong. SMOKEY FIRE settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the turn and faded.

MOONWALK BEAUTY stumbled at the start, sat within range between rivals while under a firm hold, remained on hold during a brief wait for racing room nearing the quarter pole, gained a clear path turning for home, went through it, commencing to rally, squeezed through a narrow seam between rivals in the vicinity of the eighth pole, bumping with a weakening CHAKA BWANA in the process, continued onward, grabbed the lead shortly past the sixteenth pole and dug in to preserve the decision. OATKADESTINYSCHILD contently stalked the leader while being rated, drew alongside that rival in upper stretch before asked for run, poked a head in front at the furlong ground, dug in, clinging to a narrow edge, reluctantly yielded to the top one with about a sixteenth to go but continued on with good energy to garner place honors. HENNESSY LIGHT lightly urged to a forward position, tracked the front runner from the three path, displayed a good kick down the center of the course en route for the show. HECK broke awkwardly, was steadied along at various points until the quarter pole, found herself mired behind a wall of rivals, vainly searched for racing room during the ensuing furlong while forced to remain on hold, angled outward after spotting clearance coming to the eighth pole, settled quickly into her rally after being called upon and came home with good late foot. STRATEGIC SUE unseated the jockey during the post parade and ran off for nearly a furlong before being nicely apprehended by the outrider, came away well out of the gate, raced three wide around the turn and displayed a mild rally during the stretch run. NICE AND NAUGHTY broke a bit awkwardly at the start, took the inside route , being either steadied or put under a snug hold for most of the early going, entered the lane towards the inside, completely lacking any racing room, thought making an inside bid but was forced to steady one last time when stymied in tight quarters around the furlong marker, continued the search for optimal racing clearance, spotted the needed room at the sixteenth pole, angled outward for it, then finished with belated interest. IT'S A SHAM bumped after the start, was taken hold of early while rank early, raced towards the back of the pack along the outside, came wide into the stretch, settling into the six path at the top of the lane and improved position. CHAKA BWANA hustled to the front, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead, was weakening when bumped by the top one at the eighth pole. BET TWICE RIZZI bumped after the start, raced three wide and failed to reach a contending position. INVASIVE ducked in to the rail at the half mile and was outrun.
