MALIBU ARTISTE tracked the leader under urging, vied off the rail on the turn, was asked for her best nearing the quarter-pole, battled between rivals in the stretch and wore down her stablemate POOVEY late under strong urging. POOVEY was hustled to the lead, controlled the pace through moderate fractions while on the inside, was set down at the top of the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught in the final strides. PLEASANT SISTER settled just off the pace, vied three wide on the turn, was roused coming to the quarter-pole, made a mild bid in upper stretch but was outfinished while clear for the show. KISSA MELISSA lunged a bit at the start, settled towards the rear of the field, raced inside early on the turn then moved off the rail, came three wide past the quarter-pole, gained ground while moving out in upper stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. VERSE CHOIR was well placed in fourth, angled in leaving the backstretch, waited patiently while just off the rail on the turn, was roused in upper stretch, had plenty of room on the inside but failed to respond. LADY DURLYN settled near the back of the field, was urged while off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. BOB'S DYLAN stumbled badly at the start then was taken up very sharply, spotted the field double digit lengths, raced three wide on the turn and trailed.

MOON RAVEN assumed command soon after the start under her own power, was rated on the lead towards the inside, under the watchful eye of LADY DURLYN, perched to the outside, just off her hind quarters, continued to show the way unchallenged, was let out a notch nearing the quarter pole, with a few rivals now gearing up for the stretch run, left the furlong grounds still holding a comfortable advantage and held sway. BRUNELLI within range for over six furlongs, was asked for pick up the pace swinging four wide into the lane, rallied with good energy down the center of the course to garner place honors. SOLUTIONFINDERS fought against the bit during the early going, acted more kindly upon reaching the opening turn, was unhurried along the outside before moving over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, crept into contention during the run around the second bend, briefly waited for racing room coming to the quarter pole, found the necessary clearance once the leader drifted out to the two path, in upper stretch, moved forwardly willingly during the ensuing furlong, was forced to alter course outward when the front runner shut down that alleyway, then continued on willingly to earn the show. WON O WON was steadied after bumping with N P CAT at the break, took the inside route thereafter and finished well en route for the last major share. RAPPAPORT applied mild pressure on the pacesetter from the outside, while under a firm hold, for six furlongs before weakening. BETH'S KITTEN was reserved along the outside, angled outward for optimal clearance in upper stretch, advanced readily for a couple of strides, before being forced to steady after BRUNELLI crossed over, shutting down the clear path, got clear once more after altering course, but could now muster up only a mild kick. N P CAT was bumped after stumbling at the start, lacked the necessary stretch response after being called upon. UP FOR LOVE unhurried for nearly three-quarters, while off the inside, angled outward before commencing to rally, was forced to be checked when caught behind traffic nearing the eighth pole, angled free but had no serious stretch offering. UNFORGETTABLE P J forwardly placed, was roused at the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. OMMADON'S ANSWER three wide around both turns, folded.

WHO'S WILLIE FITZ raced well back in the field, was hard ridden while two then three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, drifted in under right hand urging passing the furlong marker, bothered several rivals to his inside, closed well under left hand urging into the final sixteenth and got up late. SECOND AND ONE rushed to the lead on the inside, set the pace through solid fractions, was urged along while under pressure on the turn, extended the lead in upper stretch, remained clear into the final furlong, drifted out some late and was caught while clear for the place. GOTTA GO ROUND bumped with RUNAWAY JIM after the start, was ridden along towards the rear, raced three to four wide while hard ridden on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and finished willingly to get the show. RUNAWAY JIM bumped with GOTTA GO ROUND after the start, moved out over heels early, was urged some while in fourth, raced off the rail on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, was carried in passing the furlong marker then steadied, came out near the sixteenth-pole and missed the show. JELLO SHOT was restless in the gate, dropped back after the start, raced at the rear of the field while off the rail, angled out nearing the furlong marker, gained ground alongside GOTTA GO ROUND, steadied slightly when RUNAWAY JIM came out near the sixteenth-pole and missed the minor awards. PAYOUT showed early speed then dropped back a bit, was asked to move up outside the half-mile pole, chased while off the rail on the turn, was carried in passing the furlong marker then gave way. SWINGING AT SIRO'S broke alertly from the outside post then was hustled, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was carried in near the furlong marker then steadied and capitulated. PONTE VECCHIO was urged along a bit while off the pace, raced near the rail on the turn, came out a bit outside the furlong marker but was quickly straightened, was forced to check on the inside near the furlong marker and dropped out.

CODETTA away in good order, assumed a forward position without need of encouragement during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, sat reserved along the outside while advancing along with the remainder of the pack towards the loose leader, entered the far turn from the three path, with PRIZE CATCH drafting behind, continued a steady forward march towards the front, still not being urged until the quarter pole, took off in earnest when asked for run after entering the stretch, closed in relentlessly during the ensuing furlong, forged to a narrow edge in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, dug in with good determination, with several rivals breathing down, then proceeded to finish gamely on even terms with PRIZE CATCH for the decision. PRIZE CATCH was allowed to settle into stride leaving the starting gate, drafted behind CODETTA from the three path during the run around the second bend, was asked to pick it up a bit under mild encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, remained glued just off that rival's hind quarters as the pair headed into the lane, tipped outward one additional path settling into upper stretch, responded positively, having been now been fully set down, then charged down the center of the course to finish in a dead heat with CODETTA. UP IN LIGHTS was rank under restraint during the initial stages, acted more kindly upon reaching the opening bend, was unhurried for nearly six furlongs, while racing towards the back of the pack, was asked for a response fanning four wide into

the stretch, lost none of the momentum after being straightened away and displayed a strong kick along the outside of the course en route for the show. SMART FARMING rated along the outside, gradually closed a significant gap from the early leader leaving the first turn, continued to inch towards that rival departing the half mile pole, was asked for a response issuing her challenge coming to the quarter pole, gained readily on the front runner, came in a bit from left handed whipping at the eighth pole, shutting down HEY HEY MAMA's path, battled hard, but had to settle for the last major share. MARCH MISCHIEF between rivals on the second turn, came up empty when asked. PERFECT BERRY guided over to the rail midpoint on the backstretch, never threatened. LIGNUM VITAE raced along the outside and was outrun.

WISHINGONADREAM raced three wide around both turns, drew closer to the front runners with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, crept up to a good striking position by the five-sixteenths pole, only to lose a bit ground on his two closest rivals turning for home, with the rider choosing to sit chilly, was finally asked for a response in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, made minimal progress until nearing the sixteenth pole, closed readily thereafter to poke his nose in front one jump before the wire to earn the decision. NEHRU under a good hold for nearly a half mile, slipped off the inside approaching the far turn, remained within range, rallied in earnest when set down, came home resolutely, only to apparently run out of ground. SHIMMERING FOREST was knocked sideways after being bumped at the break, appeared eager for the lead, showed the way towards the inside while being firmly rated, met resistance for the initial time nearing the head of the stretch, but spurted away to reestablish a clear advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, came under assault from a pair of opponents leaving the sixteenth pole, continued to display gameness throughout, but had to settle for show honors. EPICURUS squeezed back at the start, saved ground until the quarter pole, and came home with good energy down the center of the course. COPS FEVER patiently stalked the leader from the outside, made his bid when ready coming to the quarter pole, was placed to a strong drive, flattened out during the final sixteenth. GRAND BLACK JAK tracked from the inside, was put to a prolonged drive and tired. SUPREME SERENE taken hold of leaving the starting gate, was forwardly place along the outside for three-quarters and folded. SMOOTH TRANSITION lightly bumped at the break, never menaced. AWESOME ENCORE bumped lightly with SMOOTH TRANSITION at the start, was always outrun thereafter.
