GO GO PINK moved willingly under her own power to assume the role of stalker, accompanied the pacesetter from the two path under rating tactics, applying mild pressure on the leader all the while, ranged up to issue her bid for the lead departing the half mile pole, still not having asked, reached even terms at the three-eighths pole, went head to head with an equally rated rival, was called upon for a response almost simultaneously when MY LUCKEY PENNEY was, edged away to a clear advantage with an eighth to go, and held sway under a vigorous hand ride. OPERA HEROINE stalked the front runners from the outside, maneuvered over to the three path soon after reaching the far turn, continued from there into the stretch and came home willingly to grab the place. FOURTH CHAPTER placed under a firm hold early, launched a four wide bid around the second bend, lacked the needed kick to reel in the top one but mustered up enough of a rally to earn the show. BELLA ATTRICE entertaining thoughts of saving ground, crossed over in front of WITCHY MEETING nearing the opening bend, resulting in that rival and a couple of others as well being steadied, scooted back to the two path, remained within striking distance along the outside, unasked and unhurried, attempted a five wide run around the far turn to reach serious contention, but could not sustain the bid after turning for home. MUSTANG FEVER tucked in nicely behind rivals in the two path during the straightaway approach to the opening bend, had the plans foiled after BELLA ATTRICE crossed over a couple of lengths in front around the seven-eighths pole, was forced to steady and swerve out three wide off another foe's heels, failed to reach a contending position thereafter. MY LUCKEY PENNEY rated towards the inside, was put to the test at the three-eighths pole, offered resistance before succumbing in upper stretch. BLUE HILL BAY well placed tracking the front runner from the pocket under a good hold, failed to fire once called upon in the lane. MIGHTY IRISH was through after going three-quarters. MESA GIRL, off a beat slowly, was steadied early and outrun. WITCHY MEETING was forced to steady shortly before reaching the first turn, took the inside route and faded.

RUNNING TAP was hustled from the start, raced on the outside while urged along, was carried out some on the backstretch, moved up to make a bid while three to four wide on the turn, gained the lead outside the furlong marker and edged clear under strong right hand urging. JUSTIN PHILLIP was restless in the gate, came away in good order then was hustled to the lead, set the pace while a bit off the rail, dropped to the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and weakened while able to hold the place. IT'S TRULY AHVEE was fractious in the gate then broke about two lengths slow, was ridden along at the back of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out in the stretch and closed gradually to get the show. ROCK HARD NICKY lost his footing at the start, was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. BANNED was bumped at the start, chased the pace while drifting out a bit, engaged the leader while two to three wide on the turn, battled between rivals into the stretch, steadied a bit while between those same rivals nearing the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the outside and tired. CHERRYZAPPER bobbed at the start then bumped with rivals, was carried out by BANNED while chasing the leader, dropped in leaving the backstretch, raced near the rail on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and also tired. MAJOR DUOMO came in at the start and bumped lightly with a rival, was carried out while urged along on the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and had nothing left.

MISS MATCH (ARG) patiently stalked the leader from the two path for nearly six furlongs, was asked to pick up the pace at the five-sixteenths pole, gained gradually during the run through the furlong grounds, kept coming relentlessly under a drive to finally wrest the lead just shy of the finish line to prove best. AMAZING assumed the lead in short order, showed the way towards the inside under with rating tactics being applied, continued along unchallenged until nearing the head of the stretch, was put to encouragement in anticipation of upcoming pressure, still maintained a clear advantage with an eighth to go, continued on with good determination, had the lead dwindle down nonetheless, gave it up shortly nearing the end, while reaching the wire just in time to preserve the place. MILLION SELLER reserved early, entered the far turn from the three path, was forced to come a bit wider, rallying in unison with the rest of the field, losing valuable ground and momentum as a result, kicked in again after being straightened away, came home with strong late foot, a bit too late. FLOATING HEART displayed sluggish early action, travelling three wide most of the way around the opening bend, gradually drew closer to the pack during the run down the backstretch, steadily worked her way over to the inside, finally successfully settling along the rail at the five-sixteenths pole, displayed a nice turn of speed, cutting the corner into the lane, loomed briefly with an eighth to go, but flattened out. MANITOBA MISS mildly prompting the pacesetter from the outside for six furlongs before folding.
