BUY WITH GOLD stalked the pace, closed three and four-wide on the far turn, chased into the stretch, bid a furlong out and moved clear then failed to contain the winner at the wire. BRISTOL INDIAN, unhurried early, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then finished all out between rivals but evened out in deep stretch. POETIC SOUL stalked the pace from the second path, was hustled late turn then evened out in the stretch. HAZARDS OF LOVE forced the pace, moved up inside the leader entering the far turn, dueled and gained a short lead upper stretch, was headed a furlong out and tired. POWER MOVE set a pressured pace, dueled in earnest on the far turn, was headed at the top of the stretch then tired a furlong out.

COLONEL BE GOOD raced midpack, came five and six-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch, finished determinedly and just missed. MASTER MICHAEL stalked the pace, chased from the rail on the turn, hustled into the stretch, bid a sixteenth out, tried gamely but was outfinished. REGIONAL EXPERTISE led early backstretch, set a reserved pace, was caught midstretch and gave way. SOIR NOIR raced off the pace, angled from three to six-wide on the turn then rallied mildly outside. CALM NIGHT, also off the early pace, angled from two-wide to four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out between horses. BROMPTON ROAD led briefly, was headed and pressed the pace, was roused at the top of the stretch but tired in the final furlong. JASAMINE COT, off slowly, closed along the rail on the backstretch and turn then flattened out in the final furlong.

SPOONFUL, in range, raced four-wide on the turn then finished all out through the stretch. SHEBA'S SECRET, in range, came five and six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out late. NEW NORMAL, close early, stalked on the turn, was blocked three-wide upper stretch then finished gamely when clear. DESTINY'S DIVA stalked early, closed up and forced the pace on the turn, bid late turn, dueled into the stretch, yielded quickly and tired. CHARISMATICALLY settled off the pace, angled from the rail to five-wide late turn, launched an all out drive but was not a threat. MESSAGE RECEIVED, in midpack early, was set down at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. POETFROMTHEPULPIT raced off the pace, angled from two to seven-wide on the turn but never reached contention. JOHAR MOON held a short lead between foes, set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, vied into the stretch and tired. MENIL raced midpack, angled from two-wide to six-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. STAY CLEAR raced off the pace, was hustled between foes and angled out late turn but had response in the stretch.

RETRACEABLE raced off the pace, angled out late turn, rallied between horses and just got up for 2nd. REBECCA'S SONG raced midpack, angled from three-wide to five-wide on the turn then rallied outside. ABSOLUTE HEAVEN stalked the pace, moved up outside the leader and the forced issue late turn, chased into the stretch and finished under an all out drive. INTERNALLYFLAWLESS raced off the pace, chased hard late turn, came four-wide into the stretch then rallied belatedly. READY TO SING, clear early, set a reserved pace, was pressured late turn but shook clear at the top of the stretch then was passed a furlong out and tired. RASHNAA, well back early, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn but never reached contention. JELLY ROLL raced off the pace, closed along the second path on the turn, was in range at the top of the stretch but flattened out in the final 16th. SHE'S THE UMPIRE stalked from between rivals, was roused upper stretch but flattened out in the final 1/16.
