POWERMOUSE forced the pace, dueled on the backstretch, shook clear midturn then yielded upper stretch. TEQUILA MAX, rated off the pace, saved ground then rallied inside. DARLINGTON stalked the pace, was roused nearing the far turn, chased hard three and four-wide and finished with a mild late run. IRISH APPROVAL settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to four-wide on the far turn, finished gamely but did not threaten. MAJOR MOVES stalked the pace, angled out midturn, chased into the stretch then flattened out late. MARTIN'S PRIDE had speed, dueled on the backstretch, yielded midturn, chased to the stretch and tired.

SKY HALO broke in the air, moved up quickly to stalk the pace, chased between foes on the turn and finished gamely to no avail. UNHINGED raced off the pace, closed late backstretch, chased along the rail on the turn and was all out through the stretch. DELRAY BEACH stalked the pace, chased angling from three to five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. MARIA'S STORY, off slowly, raced well off the pace, was hustled on the turn, angled six-wide late turn but lacked a serious rally.
