SALTY LANGFUHRN dueled on the backstretch, chased along the rail on the turn, was blocked briefly at the top of the stretch then lodged a bid a sixteenth out but was outfinished. STEP ON UP pulled to the front early, was joined on the main track, dueled, led into the turn, set a pressured pace then shook clear at the top of the stretch, was caught a sixteenth out and gave way grudgingly. FLASHY YANKEE, taken back at the start and rated well off the pace, closed four-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. FORBIDDEN BEAR stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn then tired at the top of the stretch. CHIEF BEAR dueled on the backstretch, was headed approaching the turn and dropped back, was hustled along the rail then tired in the stretch.

WHO BY FIRE dropped back midway of the backstretch, saved ground then rallied belatedly between foes. MAKAR forced the pace, dueled on the turn, shook clear upper stretch but was passed in the final furlong and tired. WELLOILEDMACHINE, in range, was hustled along four and five-wide then evened out midstretch. RAIN DANCE was hustled to an early lead, vied on the turn, yielded upper stretch and tired. MAN O' METTLE, in range, chased hard late turn then tired in the final furlong. RESAMA dropped back early, trailed the field, was roused late turn but never reached contention. CONTROLLED BLAST showed brief speed, chased on the turn, responded at the top of the stretch, swept to the lead in the final furlong and widened under a hand ride. PETER THE GROSS, in range, launched a quick move to take the lead midway of the backstretch, set a pressured pace then failed to hold the winner safe in the final furlong. DARE TO BE BEST settled off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. LOLA B. chased along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back early turn, chased hard to the stretch then evened out. ARTICULATING, rated in range, dropped back midbackstretch, chased three and four-wide on the turn but failed to menace.
