EVEN THE ODDS came from mid pack to angle out to the 6-path for a stretch bid then came home with a good strong wide rally and just missed. PUZZLE DREAM tracked the speed and was inside into the stretch, bid from there and finished with good energy. EXECUTIVE MANCER outside foes early and in the hunt on the turn, bid from between rivals turning for home then was outkicked. MATTYS DANCIN stalked the speed battle into the turn with tracking speed, kept contact turning for home then lacked a serious bid. TRUST YOUR FEELING pressed outside and led briefly then gave way to the winner and tired in the drive. HUSHYANNA settled off the pace, bid wide in the drive but had no impact. ANNA SHE IS off the pace and inside early, was never a threat.

THAT'S FUNNY was up on the pace and a factor on the turn then evened out in the run to the wire. SILVER MANCER was off the pace and failed to rally. LOTUS FLOWER hopped at the break, was off very slow and never a threat. SILK FAN hit the gate at the break and showed little thereafter. BEEJAYKAY backed away after being in striking distance into the turn. COFFEE QUEENS was bumped at the break, settled well back and had no bid. MENIL bumped and squeezed at the break, was hustled into contention then faded.
